



PRESS ACCREDITATION 75th Session

Due to the revised accreditation process, it is highly recommended that you complete this process early.

NEVADA LEGISLATURE PRESS ACCREDITATION REQUEST PROCEDURE

Those wishing to use press space within the Assembly and Senate Chambers and access press resources provided by the Legislative Counsel Bureau must be accredited by both Houses of the Nevada Legislature and must obtain and wear a press badge issued by the Legislative Counsel Bureau. NOTE: Press may be restricted from entering the press area of the Chambers if they are not wearing their badges.

Please go to the Legislative Police Office, Legislative Building, 401 S. Carson St., Room 1144, Carson City, Nevada, and complete the Press Accreditation form. The Legislative Police staff will take your picture for your badge (which should be available the next day). Your application will be reviewed by Barry Smith, Nevada Press Association or Bob Fisher, Nevada Broadcasters Association, who will make the recommendation for accreditation. Should they not recommend accreditation, you will be contacted. When the recommendation has been made, your badge should be available to pick up. It is suggested you call the Legislative Police (775) 684-6812 to make sure your badge is ready.

Once the above process is approved, your name will be sent to each of the Houses and read into the record.

Requests received and approved prior to the first day of the legislative session will be submitted to each House for action on the first day and will be published in each House's Journal for the day the motion was made. Requests received after session has commenced will be submitted for action as soon as possible after receipt and approval.
