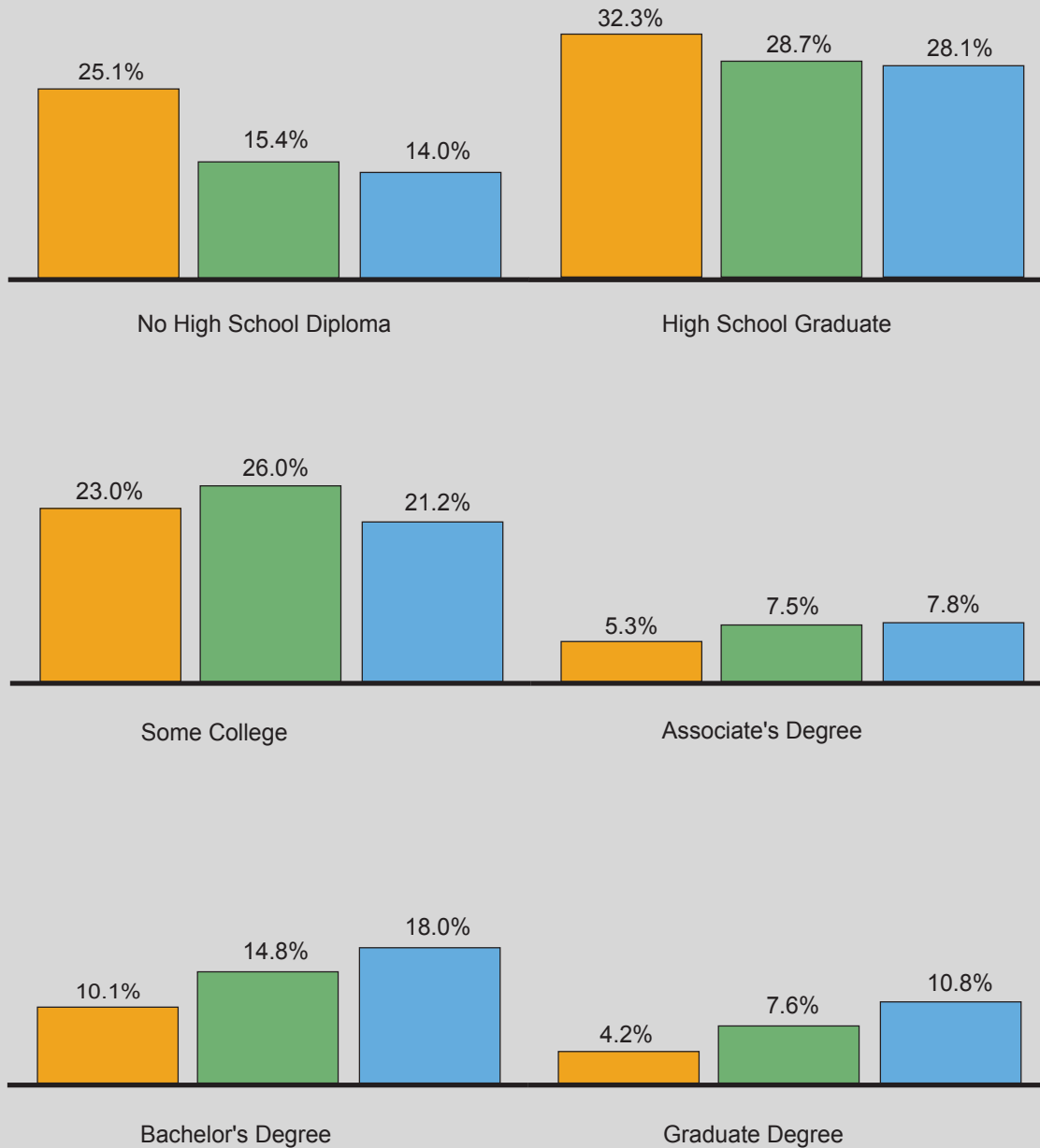

Educational Attainment for Population 25 Years and Over



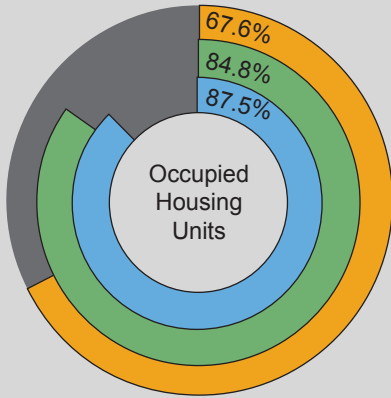

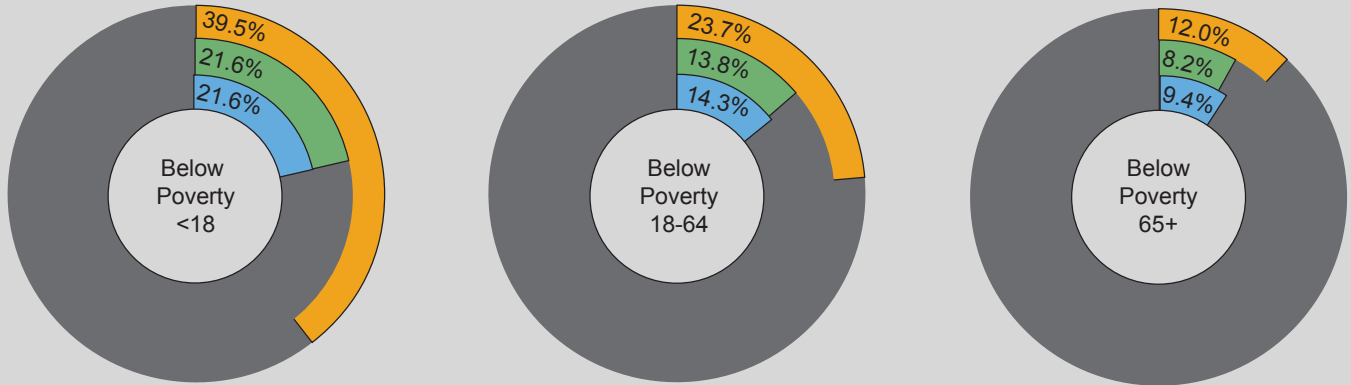

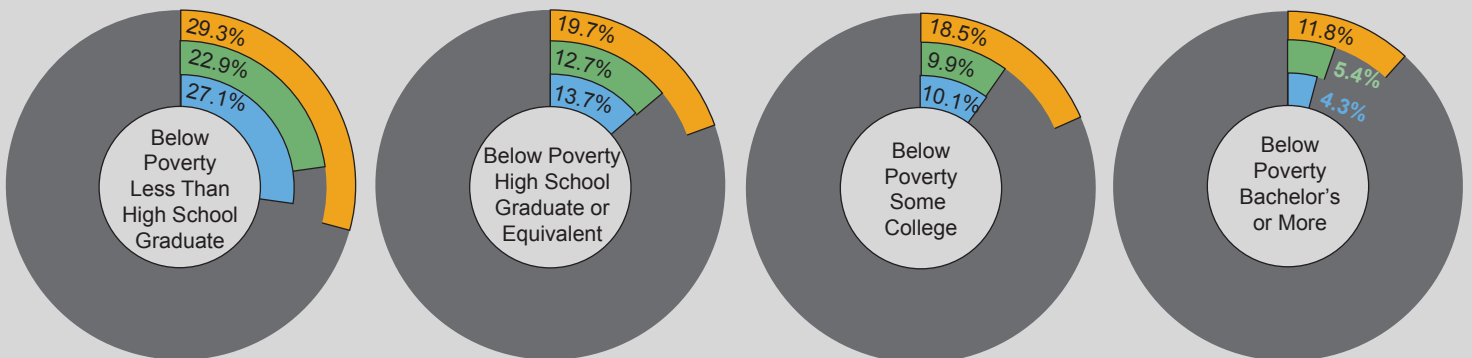
Poverty Level by Age

Poverty Level by Education



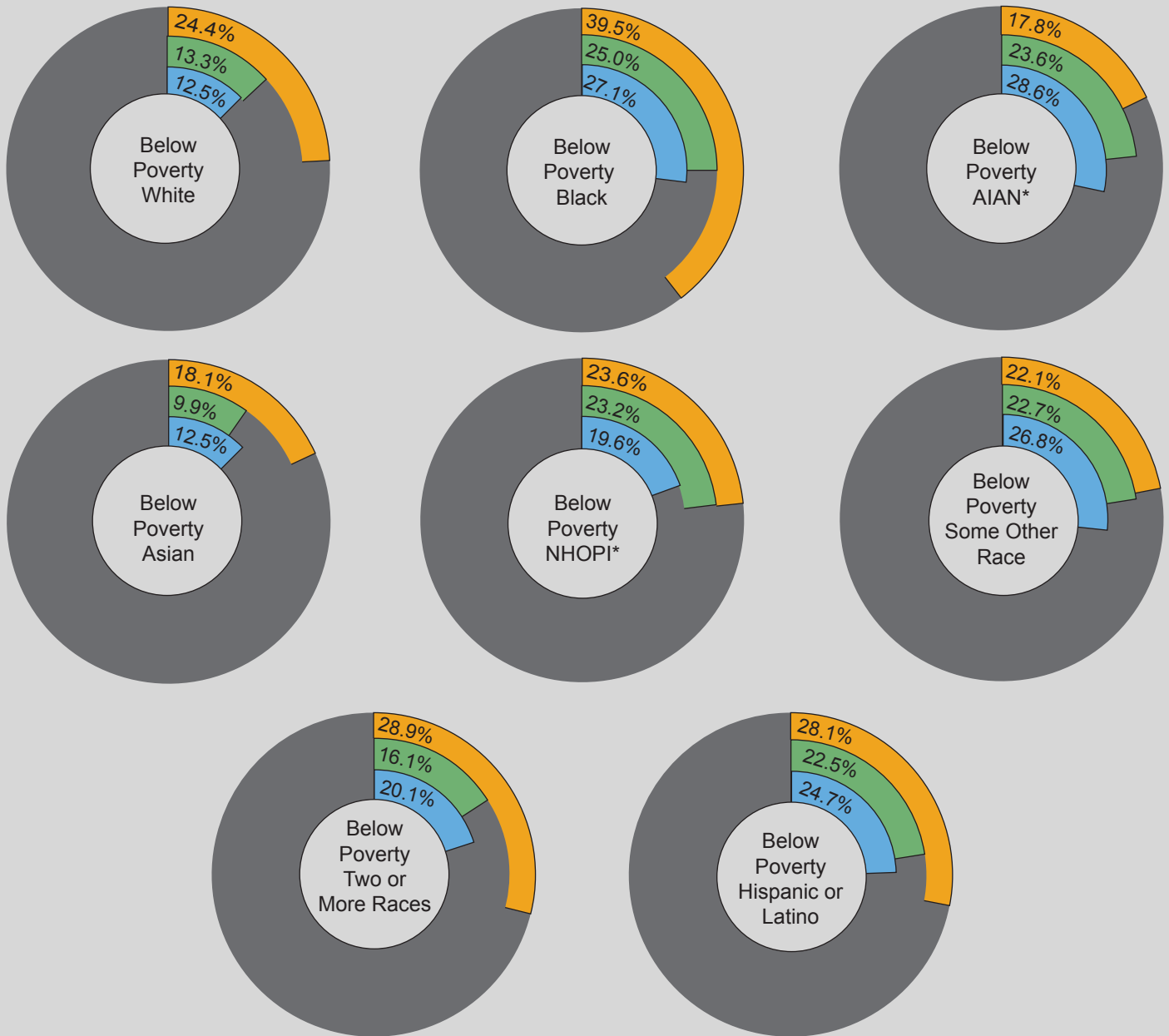

Health Insurance by Age



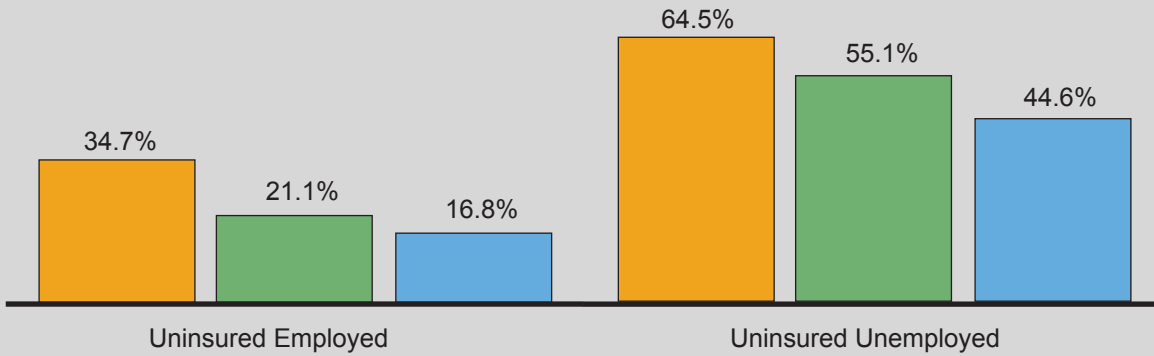

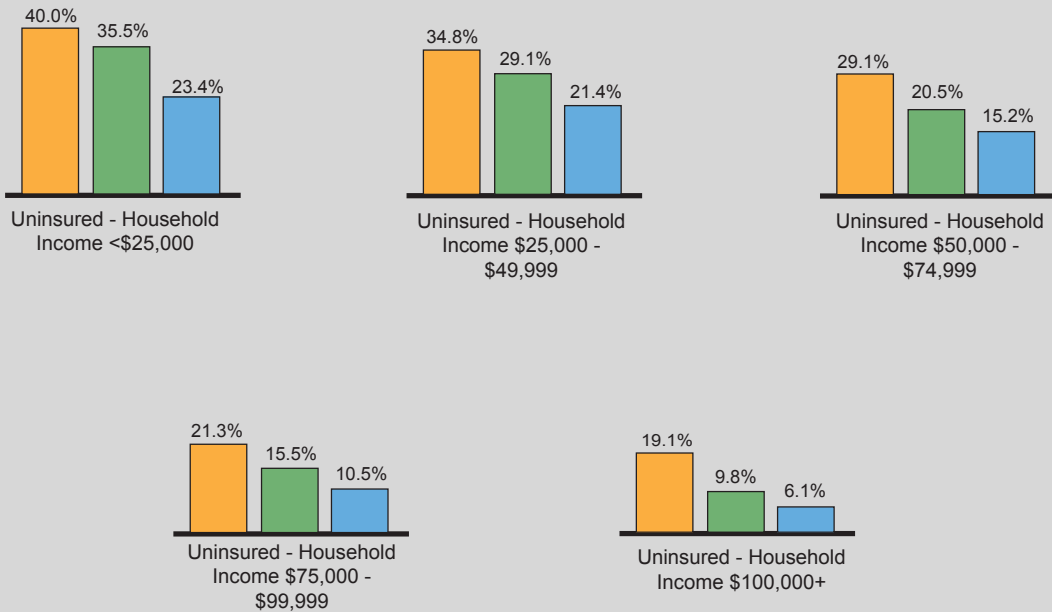
Health Insurance by Employment Status

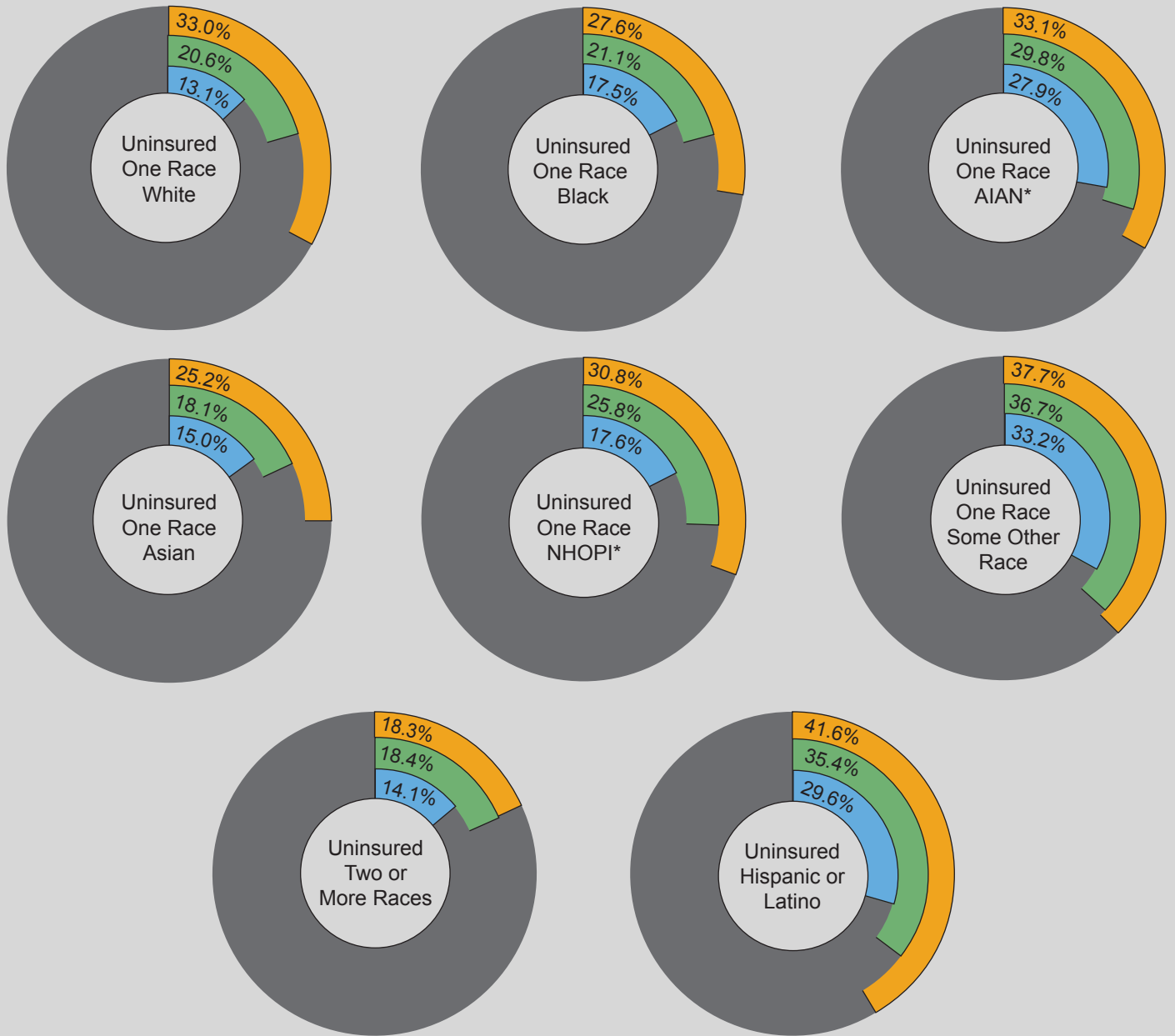

Health Insurance by Race



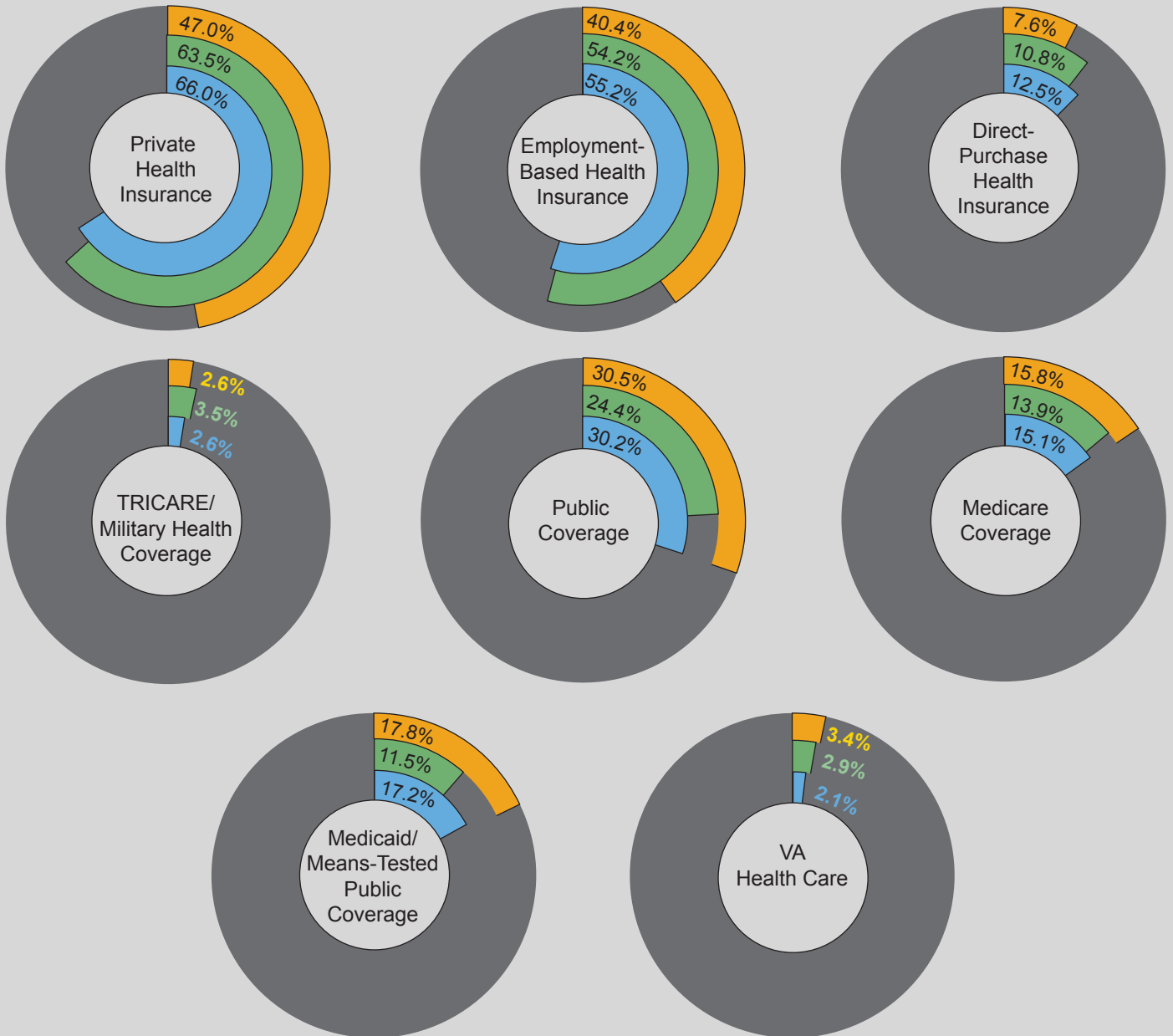

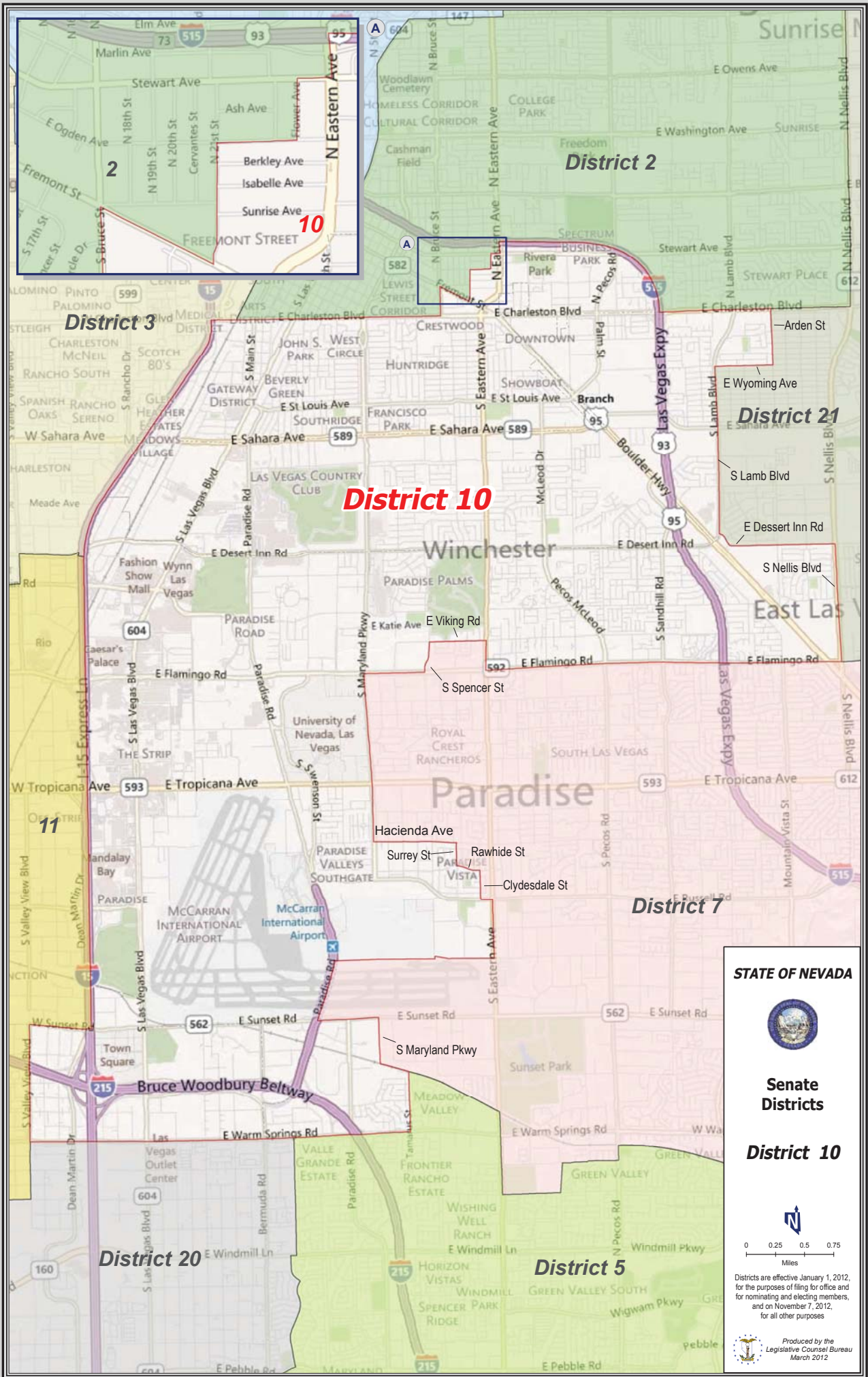
