Notice of Workshop to Solicit Comments on Proposed Regulation

The Nevada State Board of Medical Examiners (Board), located at 9600 Gateway Drive, Reno, Nevada 89521, (775) 688-2559, is proposing the amendment of a regulation pertaining to Chapter 630 of the Nevada Administrative Code. The public workshop has been set for 10:00 a.m., on Tuesday, September 25, 2018, at the Nevada State Board of Dental Examiners, located at 6010 S. Rainbow Blvd., Bldg. A, Ste. 1, Las Vegas, Nevada and videoconferenced to the Nevada State Board of Medical Examiners located at 9600 Gateway Drive, Reno, Nevada 89521. The purpose of the workshop is to solicit comments from interested persons on the following general topic that may be addressed in the proposed regulation:

R008-17 Repeal of NAC 630.205 in its entirety and amendment of NAC 630.187 to remove reference to Dietary Guidelines and update Guidelines for Chronic Use of Opioids.
