A REGULATION relating to veterinary medicine; allowing the use of the identifier “veterinary nurse” in veterinary facilities.

**Legislative Counsel’s Digest:**

Existing law. . .

**Section 1.** Chapter 638 of NAC is hereby amended by adding thereto the provisions set forth as section 2 of this regulation.

**Sec. 2.** *A supervising veterinarian may allow licensed veterinary technicians employed and working within the veterinary facility to be referred to and to identify themselves as veterinary nurses. When not working within the veterinary facility, the licensed veterinary technician must still identify himself or herself as a licensed veterinary technician.*
