

## **Informational Statement Form**

**The following statement is submitted for adopted amendments to Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) Chapter 644A.**

**1. A clear and concise explanation of the need for the adopted regulation.**

This regulation is necessary to update the regulations to comply with recent statutory changes.

**2. A description of how public comment was solicited, a summary of public response, and an explanation how other interested persons may obtain a copy of the summary.**

Copies of the proposed regulations, notices of workshop and notices of intent to act upon the regulation were sent by U.S. mail and email to persons who were known to have an interest in the subject of industrial development bonds as well as any persons who had specifically requested such notice.

These documents were also made available at the website of the State Library, 100 Stewart Street, Carson City, Nevada, for inspection by members of the public during business hours. Additional copies of the notice and the regulation to be Adopted will be available at the Nevada State Board of Cosmetology office located at 8945 West Russell Rd, Ste 100, Las Vegas, Nevada 89148 and Nevada State Board of Cosmetology office located at 740 Del Monte Lane Suite 12, Reno, Nevada 89511 for inspection and copying by members of the public during business hours.

**5. A description of how comment was solicited from affected businesses, a summary of their response, and an explanation how other interested persons may obtain a copy of the summary.**

The Nevada State Board of Cosmetology requested input from small business owners and operators. A survey was sent to each of the Board's licensed businesses, including schools of cosmetology asking for input as to the projected adverse and beneficial impacts of the proposed regulation changes.

Surveys were sent to all licensed Nevada cosmetology schools and businesses via email. In addition to the open-ended comment section at the end of the survey, business owners/operators were asked whether they anticipated any direct or indirect economic benefits or adverse effects

upon their businesses. Survey participants were able to select “yes”, “no” or “unknown” as their response.

Board staff reviewed the “yes” responses for businesses that indicated that a regulation change was likely to have a negative impact on their business’. Any “yes” response was compared to the open-ended comment response at the end of the survey to determine the specific concerns of the individual business owner/operator.

The survey was sent via Alchemer, an online survey tool. Responses were solicited from small businesses twice (December 2022 and March 2023). In total, 188 responses were collected.

The end of the survey left room for open-ended comments and was intended to provide the small business owner or operator the ability to expand on his/her responses.

**6. If the regulation was adopted without changing any part of the proposed regulation, a summary of the reasons for adopting the regulation without change.**

The permanent regulation was adopted on December 11, 2023 and included the changes suggested at the workshop and public hearing regarding Executive Order 2023-003.

**7. The estimated economic effect of the adopted regulation on the businesses which it is to regulate and on the public. These must be stated separately, and each case must include: (a) Both adverse and beneficial effects; and (b) Both immediate and long-term effects.**

Regulated Businesses:

(a) Both adverse and beneficial effects: The Nevada State Board of Cosmetology estimates a neutral economic effect for businesses based on the statements from small business owners.

(b) Both immediate and long-term effects: The Nevada State Board of Cosmetology estimates no significant immediate or long term effects on businesses based on the statements from small business owners.

The Nevada State Board of Cosmetology estimates no immediate and long-term economic effects as well as no adverse and beneficial economical effects for members of the public.

**8. The estimated cost to the agency for enforcement of the adopted regulation. There is no additional cost to the agency for enforcement of this regulation.**

The Nevada State Board of Cosmetology does not anticipate there being an additional cost to enforce the proposed regulation.

**9. A description of any regulations of other state or government agencies which the proposed regulation overlaps or duplicates and a statement explaining why the duplication or overlapping is necessary. If the regulation overlaps or duplicates a federal regulation, the name of the regulating federal agency.**

This regulation does not overlap or duplicate any regulations of other state or local government agencies.  
This regulation does not overlap or duplicate any federal regulations.

**10. If the regulation includes provisions that are more stringent than a federal regulation which regulates the same activity, a summary of such provisions.**

There are no federal regulations that apply.

**11. If the regulation provides a new fee or increases an existing fee, the total annual amount the agency expects to collect and the manner in which the money will be used.**

To comply with changes made in NRS 644A.470, Section 21 of the regulation: (1) sets forth the fee for an examination as an advanced esthetician and hair braider. (2) increases the fee for a reexamination for licensure or registration from \$75 to \$95.

The anticipated amount to be collected annually on examination fees for advanced estheticians and braiders is \$22,890. The anticipated amount to be collected annually on re-examination fees for all license types is \$ 116,755. These estimates are based on testing volumes from 2023 (148 advanced estheticians, 51 hair braiders, and 1,229 retake examinations). This figure can fluctuate based on the actual amount of applicants received. The fees collected are used to pay for examinations delivered from a third party theory examination vendor.

## Exhibit B

The Nevada State Board of Cosmetology held a public hearing on March 6, 2023 to solicit testimony from the public, licensees, and other industry stakeholders regarding Executive Order 2023-003. The meeting had a total of 33 participants, including both Northern and Southern Nevada. The Board of Cosmetology considered each statement received, both in person and written, and included any appropriate suggestions for removal or modification. The Board noted that many of the comments heard were not applicable to Executive Order 2023-003 as they were items defined in statute, including the schedule of fees (NRS.644.520), composition of the Board (NRS 644A.200), esthetics scope (NRS 644A.075), and financial statements for opening a school (NRS 644A.700(c)).

Regulations NAC 644A.105, NAC 644A.305, NAC 644A.510, NAC 644A.725, NAC 644A.210 have been reviewed and selected for modification to either be improved upon and/or streamlined to reduce inhibition of economic growth for individuals and businesses with no estimated financial impact (positive or negative) on the agency, the State of Nevada, business, or individuals.

The Board proposed improvements to the existing language of NAC 644A.105 to modify the expiration date for registrations. As it stands all registrations expire on December 31, regardless of when they were initially issued. The proposed change will allow registrants a full year for their registration. The anticipated impact of this change is estimated to be positive for both individuals and businesses.

The Board proposed improvements to the existing language of NAC 644A.305 to reduce the processing time for apprenticeship applicants. This modification would allow apprenticeship applicants to begin their apprenticeship faster. The anticipated impact of this change is estimated to be positive for both individuals and businesses.

The Board proposed improvements to the existing language of NAC 644A.510 to remove barriers to individuals and business who provide services outside the jurisdiction of cosmetology. The anticipated impact of this change is estimated to be positive for both individuals and businesses.

The Board proposed improvements to the existing language of NAC 644A.725 to allow for portable sinks in certain circumstances. This modification should improve accessibility to water and sanitation services. The anticipated impact of this change is estimated to be positive for both individuals and businesses.

The Board proposed improvements to the existing language of NAC 644A.210 to grant licensed hair braiders the ability to receive a limited license. This proposed modification should increase business opportunities for licensed hair braiders. The anticipated impact of this change is estimated to be positive for both individuals and businesses.
