# 2023 Regulatory Review

Regulations related to the PPP must be in place no later than the last business day of September (Sept 29, 2023)

## 1. New PPP regulations - Part 1 (NACs in *italics* are new)

- a. **NAC 293.110** – **Sample ballots: Presidential Preference Primary elections.** The county clerk shall:
  1. Provide an electronic copy of the sample ballot for the presidential preference primary election prepared pursuant to NRS 293.565 to each candidate who has filed with the Secretary of State a declaration of candidacy.
  2. If only one major party has two or more candidates file for the presidential preference primary, the county clerk is only required to send sample ballots to the voters who have chosen that party on the form to pre-register or register to vote not later than 20 days before the date of an election in accordance with NRS 293.565(7).
  3. Provide an electronic copy of each sample ballot for a presidential preference primary election prepared pursuant to NRS 293.565, to the Secretary of State.
  4. Post a copy of the sample ballot or a list of candidates in a conspicuous place in the county clerk's office.
- b. **NAC 298.020** - Voters who are authorized to vote pursuant to NRS 298.250 or NRS 298.259 and who are otherwise qualified to vote, may do so pursuant to NRS 293.269915 or NRS 293.269951 using a system of approved electronic transmission established by the Secretary of State
- c. **NAC 298.030** – The withdrawal of candidacy period identified in NRS 293.202 applies to candidates for Presidential Preference Primaries.
- d. **NAC 298.050** – The challenge of qualification period identified in NRS 293.182 applies to candidates for Presidential Preference Primaries.
- e. **NAC 298.200** - For the purposes of Recounts and Contests in presidential preference primary elections, the final canvass of the vote shall be interpreted to mean the date of certification of the final results by the Secretary of State in accordance with NRS 298.720(2).
- f. **NAC 293.210** - This one is the new declaration for EASE for Tribal Voters. It should duplicate “NAC 293.208 Declaration of registered voter with a disability” except be modified for a Tribal Voter pursuant to SB216 (2023).
