## ADOPTED REGULATION OF THE

## NEVADA INTERSCHOLASTIC ACTIVITIES ASSOCIATION

AUTHORITY: § 1, NRS 385B.060.

A REGULATION relating to interscholastic athletic events; establishing the maximum number of teams a school may offer for each sanctioned sport in which the school participates; authorizing a school to establish a maximum number of pupils who may participate on each such team roster; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

## **Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

Existing law requires the Nevada Interscholastic Activities Association to adopt rules and regulations concerning interscholastic athletic events. (NRS 385B.060) This regulation limits a school to establishing one varsity team, one junior varsity team and one freshman team for each sanctioned sport in which the school participates. This regulation also authorizes a school to establish a maximum number of pupils who may participate in such sports on each such team roster.

- **Section 1.** Chapter 385B of NAC is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:
- 1. A school may establish not more than one varsity team, one junior varsity team and one freshman team for each sanctioned sport in which the school participates.
- 2. For each team described in subsection 1, a school may establish, on a form approved by the Association for the team roster, a maximum number of pupils who may participate on each team, as determined by the school district, school or team coach.
