NAC 306

Amend NAC 306.015(6) to clarify that a request to remove a name from a
petition must not be accepted if it is sent by email, making it line up with the
other requirements of NAC 295.050(2)

NAC 295.050 Request to remove person's name from petition. (NRS 293.124, 293.247, 295.055) A person who requests the county clerk to remove the person's name from a petition for initiative or referendum pursuant to subsection 4 of NRS 295.055 must submit the request in writing to the county clerk. The request:

- 1. Must contain the person's original signature.
- 2. Must not be accepted by the county clerk if:
- (a) The request is submitted to the county clerk by electronic mail;
- (b) The county clerk is unable to determine the name of the person requesting the removal; or
- (c) The original signature of the person on the request does not match the signature or a facsimile thereof on the person's original application to register to vote.

2. NAC 293

- Relating to NRS 293.1277 A regulation that clarifies that clerks are able to verify signatures against all signatures of the voter available in the records of the clerk if the voter is one of the categories of voter identified in NRS 293.1277(6) who are:
 - (a) A person [who] registers to vote using the system established by the Secretary of State pursuant to NRS 293.671;
 - (b) A person [who] registers to vote pursuant to NRS 293D.230 and signs his or her application to register to vote using a digital signature or an electronic signature; or
 - (c) A person [who] is registered to vote by an automatic voter registration agency

3. NAC 293

Clarify the process to gather the "Raw Count" for a petition under NRS 293.1276
means that the county clerk or staff must count each signature on the petition
including those crossed off and only may exclude those properly requested for
removal through the county clerk pursuant to NAC 295.050 or NAC 306.XXXX
