The following document is the initial draft regulation proposed by the agency submitted on 02/16/2024

NAC 390.117 Attendance at adult high school program for test preparation. (NRS 385.080, 390.055) The board of trustees of a school district may allow a person who is at least 16 years of age but less than 18 years of age who has withdrawn from high school so that he or she may take a high school equivalency assessment to attend an adult high school program only for the purpose of test preparation. When a person under the age of 18 passes the high school equivalency they shall not continue attending an adult high school program until turning 18.
