LEGISLATIVE REVIEW OF ADOPTED REGULATIONS AS REQUIRED BY

NRS 233B.066

LCB FILE R048-24

The following statement is submitted for adopted amendments to Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) 477

- 1. A clear and concise explanation of the need for the adopted regulation.
 - A. Periodic updating of the editions of codes and standards as required by NRS 477.030(1) to allow for new technologies, techniques and materials in construction.
 - B. Periodic, comprehensive review and updating, in accordance with NRS 233B.050(1)(e), to the State Fire Marshal Division's regulation in NAC Chapter 477 to comply with existing statute and industry practices, remove outdated requirements and correct spelling and other language issues found during the review. The adopted regulation establishes certain requirements relating to the inspection of a fire damper, smoke damper or combination fire and smoke damper, smoke control system, Type 1 exhaust system and associated ventilation systems. This amendment also revises requirements for submitting certain data for the National Fire Incident Reporting System.
- 2. A description of how public comment was solicited, a summary of public response, and an explanation how other interested persons may obtain a copy of the summary.

Copies of the proposed regulations, notices of workshop and notices of intent to act upon the regulation were sent by U.S. mail and email to persons who were known to have an interest in the subject matter as well as any persons who had specifically requested such notice. These documents were also made available at the website of the State Fire Marshal Division, www.fire.nv.us, mailed to all County libraries in Nevada and posted at the following locations: (see Exhibit "A" attached for posting locations) Other interested parties may obtain a copy of the summary by either visiting the state fire marshal website to download the summary or request a copy of the summary directly to the State Fire Marshal.

A workshop was held in conjunction with a meeting to provide advice on the subject matter established pursuant to NAC 477 on December 5, 2023 and the minutes of that meeting, attached hereto as Exhibit "B", contain a summary of the discussion

held regarding the proposed amendments. There were no proposed amendments. Thereafter, on or about June 17, 2024, the State Fire Marshal Division issued a Notice of Intent to Act Upon a Regulation

The regulation was adopted on July 31, 2024 by the State Fire Marshal without change. There was no change to the regulation as industry was in favor of the requirements relating to the inspection of a fire damper, smoke damper or combination fire and smoke damper, smoke control system, Type 1 exhaust system and associated ventilation systems. Also, there was no opposition to the change in reporting requirements to the National Fire Incident Reporting System.
