INFORMATIONAL STATEMENT FORM

The following statement is submitted for adopted amendments to Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) Chapter 707.100.

1. **A clear and concise explanation of the need for the adopted regulation.**
NAC 707.100 is being repealed because it is duplicative of what statute requires. The Records, Communications and Compliance Division (RCCD) has developed internal policies and procedures for the collection, maintenance and use of emergency contact information.
2. **A description of how public comment was solicited, a summary of public response, and an explanation how other interested persons may obtain a copy of the summary.**
Copies of the proposed regulation repeal, notices of workshop and notices of intent to act upon the regulation were posted on the Division's public website. The notice of intent to act upon a regulation was also posted on the Nevada Public Notice website and the Nevada State Legislature website. Copies of the proposed regulation repeal, notices of workshop and notices of intent to act upon the regulation were emailed to all Nevada criminal justice agencies and were posted at the Nevada State Library, Archives and Public Records, Department of Motor Vehicles, Carson City Library, Department of Public Safety Southern Command and the Las Vegas-Clark County Library District. Public comment was solicited by seeking written comments be sent to RCCD, as well as public comment during the hearings. The Division did not receive any public response.
