

## Digest for Adopted Regulation R\_001-12

Existing law requires the State Board of Education to prescribe the courses of study for the public high schools in this State. (NRS 385.110) Existing law also authorizes the State Board for Career and Technical Education, which consists of the members of the State Board of Education, to establish policies and adopt regulations for career and technical education in the public schools. (NRS 388.360)

Existing regulations prescribe the elective courses of study that may be offered in a public high school, including a course of study in employability skills. (NAC 389.555) **Section 1** of this regulation revises this course of study in employability skills for career readiness to include standards in the following areas: (1) personal qualities and skills; (2) professional knowledge and skills; and (3) technological knowledge and skills. Existing regulations prescribe a program of career and technical education, including the general requirements for the program. (NAC 389.800) **Section 2** of this regulation revises these general requirements to include instruction in the newly revised standards in employability skills for career readiness.
