

Digest for Adopted Regulation R_043-11

Existing law requires the Board of Medical Examiners to adopt regulations regarding the licensure of practitioners of respiratory care, including, without limitation, the procedures for applying for and issuing licenses. (NRS 630.279) Existing law further requires a person who wishes to practice respiratory care in this State to complete an educational program for respiratory care which has been approved by the Commission on Accreditation of Allied Health Education Programs or its successor organization or the Committee on Accreditation for Respiratory Care or its successor organization. (NRS 630.277)

This regulation requires an applicant for such a license to submit to the Board of Medical Examiners proof of completion of an educational program as a practitioner of respiratory care that is approved by one of the organizations listed in existing law.
