

## Digest for Adopted Regulation R\_052-11

Existing law requires the State Environmental Commission to adopt regulations governing the operation of underground storage tanks in this State. (NRS 459.826)

**Section 5** of this regulation requires an owner or operator of an underground storage tank to designate one or more persons as a Class A operator, Class B operator and Class C operator for each underground storage tank he or she owns or operates. **Section 5** further establishes the duties of an owner or operator and requires an owner or operator to maintain a record for each designee which includes the name of the designee, the date of designation and the class of designation. **Sections 6 and 7** of this regulation establish the training requirements for each class of operator, require an owner or operator to ensure that each designee receives the requisite training and require an owner or operator to maintain a record of the completion of required training by the designee. **Section 8** of this regulation authorizes the Division of Environmental Protection of the State Department of Conservation and Natural Resources to require the retraining of a Class A operator or a Class B operator, or both, if the Division finds that an underground storage tank is not operating in compliance with certain federal and state laws and regulations.
