

Digest for Adopted Regulation R_060-11

Existing law requires the Board of Medical Examiners to license, regulate and discipline physicians, physician assistants, practitioners of respiratory care and perfusionists. (NRS 630.130, 630.269, 630.275, 630.279)

Under existing regulations, if a committee conducting an investigation of a complaint against a physician or physician assistant finds that the physician or physician assistant tests positive for exposure to the human immunodeficiency virus, the committee is required to appoint a group of specialists to review the practice of the licensee and make certain recommendations to the committee. (NAC 630.243) This regulation requires a committee to follow that procedure if the committee conducting an investigation of a complaint against a practitioner of respiratory care or perfusionist finds that the practitioner or perfusionist tests positive for exposure to the human immunodeficiency virus.
