

Digest for Adopted Regulation R_067-11

Existing law authorizes the Secretary of State to adopt such regulations to carry out and ensure compliance with the provisions of existing law governing the conduct of registered agents. In addition, existing law authorizes a district court, upon an application of the Secretary of State, to enjoin any person from serving as a registered agent or as an officer, director or managing agent of a registered agent if the court finds that the registered agent engaged in conduct in his or her capacity as registered agent that was intended to deceive or defraud the public or to promote illegal activities. (NRS 77.430)

This regulation adopts certain requirements to govern the conduct of registered agents for entities transacting business in this State. **Section 2** of this regulation prohibits an entity from acting as the registered agent of another entity if the entity which is acting as registered agent is not authorized to transact business in this State. **Section 3** of this regulation requires the location for the service of process on entities represented by the registered agent to satisfy certain requirements. **Section 4** of this regulation authorizes the Secretary of State to demand information to investigate an allegation that a registered agent has violated a provision of existing law or certain regulations. **Section 5** of this regulation requires a registered agent and the entities represented by the registered agent to take certain actions if a district court enjoins the registered agent from serving as a registered agent because the registered agent has committed certain illegal acts. **Sections 6-8** of this regulation enact provisions prohibiting a registered agent or person holding himself or herself out as willing to serve as the registered agent of an entity from producing or directing the production of certain correspondence, publications and websites which are deceptive or intended to promote illegal activity.
