

Digest for Adopted Regulation R_125-08

Existing law requires the Administrator of the Division of Industrial Relations of the Department of Business and Industry to adopt regulations for mine health and safety as necessary to provide safe and healthful working conditions at mines. (NRS 512.131)

Section 5 of this regulation requires that each operator of an underground mine establish a ground support plan for underground mine excavation, provide training in the ground support plan to certain employees and provide a copy of the plan to the Mine Safety and Training Section of the Division. **Sections 6-11** of this regulation revise various provisions relating to health and safety standards for a mine, including provisions relating to mercury exposure.
