

## Digest for Adopted Regulation R\_126-11

Existing law allows the Department of Motor Vehicles to adopt regulations necessary for the administration of chapter 485 of NRS. (NRS 485.130) Existing law also requires the Director of the Department to adopt regulations to carry out the provisions of NRS 485.313, which relates to the creation of a system for verifying the maintenance of insurance by owners of motor vehicles. (NRS 485.313)

**Section 1** of this regulation requires at least one registered owner of a vehicle to be designated as the person responsible for maintaining insurance on the vehicle and subject to the penalties for a failure to maintain such insurance. **Section 1** also requires the Department to maintain a record of each suspension of registration for a failure to maintain insurance for at least 5 years after the reinstatement of registration and to treat a subsequent suspension within 5 years after a reinstatement as a subsequent offense for the purposes of NRS 482.557. **Section 1** also provides that a certificate of financial responsibility required to be filed pursuant to NRS 482.557 is not transferable. Additionally, **section 1** allows a registered owner to request a hearing for a suspension of registration or a suspension of his or her driver's license caused by a lack or lapse of insurance and provides the grounds for which such a hearing will not be granted. Finally, **section 1** requires the Department to count all days on which a motor vehicle was not insured when assessing a penalty pursuant to NRS 482.557.

**Sections 2-4** of this regulation remove reference to NAC 485.165, which is repealed by **section 5** of this regulation. NAC 485.165 governed submission of certain records by nonelectronic means. **Sections 2 and 3** also remove internal references which specify records governed by those sections.
