

**LEGISLATIVE REVIEW OF AMENDED REGULATIONS AS REQUIRED BY  
ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURED ACT, NRS 233B.066  
LCB FILE R082-11**

The following informational statement is submitted for amendments, repeal, or adoption of regulations under Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) Chapter 584.

**1. A description of how public comment was solicited, a summary of public response, an explanation how other interested persons may obtain a copy of the summary.**

The possibility of amending, repealing, or adopting regulations contained under Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) Chapter 584 was discussed at the regular meeting of the Nevada Dairy Commission on June 22, 2011. Notices were sent out to all Dairy Commission Licensees and posted at various locations indicating the dates of the workshop and hearing and soliciting any written comments. A workshop was held on November 1, 2011, in Reno, NV, with teleconferencing to Las Vegas, NV. On March 21, 2012, a public hearing was held in Reno, NV, with teleconferencing to Las Vegas, NV. Public response was positive to the changes to the regulations and the regulation changes were as permanent by the Dairy Commission on March 21, 2012. **3. A description of how comment was solicited from affected businesses, a summary of their response, and an explanation how other interested persons may obtain a copy of the summary.**

Comments were solicited from affected business by a direct mail-out to all licensees of the Nevada Dairy Commission and by the posting of required notices for the above meetings as well as posting to our website. **4. If the regulation was adopted without changing any part of the proposed regulation, a summary of the reasons for adopting the regulation without change.**

The amended, repealed, and adopted regulations were adopted at the Nevada Dairy Commission Meeting on March 21, 2012, with no changes to the LCB Draft of Proposed Regulations R-082-11 dated February 8, 2012.

- 5. The estimated economic effect of the amended regulation on the businesses that it is to regulate and on the public. These must be stated separately, and each case must include:**

- a. There is expected to be no adverse economic effect or impact on any dairy business or the public. The change will benefit dairy licensees by simplifying or eliminating outdated or unnecessary regulations.
- b. The immediate and long-term effect of these regulations will be to make the Dairy Commission regulations more user friendly and easier to understand for the dairy industry.

- 6. The estimated cost to the agency for enforcement of the amended regulation.**

Since this amendment is an administrative change, there will be no cost for enforcement.

- 7. A description of any regulations of other state of government agencies that the proposed regulation overlaps or duplicated, and a statement explaining why the duplication or overlapping is necessary. There are no other state or governmental agency regulations that the proposed amendment duplicates.
