SUMMARY—Authorizes certain providers of health care to provide voluntary health care service in this State in association with certain organizations. (BDR 54-245)

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AN ACT relating to health care; authorizing a provider of health care who is licensed or certified in this State or in another state or territory of the United States to provide voluntary health care service in this State in association with a sponsoring organization; establishing certain restrictions on the provision of voluntary health care service by a provider of health care; requiring a sponsoring organization to register and file certain reports with the Health Division of the Department of Health and Human Services; requiring each contract of professional liability insurance offered in this State to include certain coverage relating to the provision of voluntary health care service; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.



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**Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

1      **Section 7** of this bill authorizes a provider of health care who is licensed or  
2 certified in this State or another state or territory of the United States to provide  
3 voluntary health care service in this State without charge to the patient if the service  
4 is provided in association with a sponsoring organization that is registered with the  
5 Health Division of the Department of Health and Human Services. **Section 7**  
6 prohibits a provider of health care from providing voluntary health care service  
7 under certain circumstances and from accepting compensation for the provision of  
8 such service. **Section 8** of this bill requires a sponsoring organization to register  
9 with the Health Division and to include with the registration certain information  
10 regarding the sponsoring organization. **Section 8** also requires a sponsoring  
11 organization to file quarterly reports with the Health Division containing certain  
12 information relating to the provision of voluntary health care service by a provider  
13 of health care in association with the sponsoring organization. **Section 8** requires  
14 the sponsoring organization to maintain a record of such reports for not less than 5  
15 years and to make the reports available for inspection by the Health Division upon  
16 reasonable request. **Section 11** of this bill provides that each policy of professional  
17 liability insurance delivered, issued for delivery or renewed on or after October 1,  
18 2013, must include coverage for a practitioner who provides voluntary health care  
19 service in association with a sponsoring organization.

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THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1      **Section 1.** Chapter 629 of NRS is hereby amended by adding  
2 thereto the provisions set forth as sections 2 to 9, inclusive, of this  
3 act.

4      **Sec. 2.** *As used in sections 2 to 9, inclusive, of this act, unless  
5 the context otherwise requires, the words and terms defined in  
6 sections 3, 4 and 5 of this act have the meanings ascribed to them  
7 in those sections.*

8      **Sec. 3.** *"Health Division" means the Health Division of the  
9 Department of Health and Human Services.*

10     **Sec. 4.** *"Sponsoring organization" means an organization  
11 that:*

12     *1. Organizes or arranges for the provision of voluntary health  
13 care service in association with one or more providers of health  
14 care; and*

15     *2. Is registered with the Health Division pursuant to section 8  
16 of this act.*

17     **Sec. 5.** *"Voluntary health care service" means professional  
18 health care service that is provided to a patient by a provider of  
19 health care:*

20     *1. Without charge to the patient or to a third party on behalf  
21 of the patient; and*

22     *2. In association with a sponsoring organization.*

23     **Sec. 6.** *The Legislature hereby finds and declares that:*



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1       **1. Access to high-quality health care service is of concern to  
2 all persons;**

3       **2. Access to such service is severely limited for some residents  
4 of this State, particularly those who reside in remote, rural areas  
5 or in the inner city;**

6       **3. Physicians and other providers of health care have  
7 traditionally worked to ensure broad access to health care service;**

8       **4. Many providers of health care from this State and other  
9 states or territories of the United States are willing to volunteer  
10 their services to address the health care needs of Nevadans who  
11 may otherwise not be able to obtain such service; and**

12       **5. It is the public policy of this State to encourage and  
13 facilitate the provision of voluntary health care service.**

14       **Sec. 7. 1. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the  
15 contrary and except as otherwise provided in this section, a  
16 provider of health care may provide voluntary health care service  
17 in this State in association with a sponsoring organization.**

18       **2. A provider of health care shall not provide voluntary  
19 health care service in this State if:**

20           **(a) The professional license or certificate of the provider of  
21 health care is suspended or revoked pursuant to disciplinary  
22 proceedings in this State or in any other state or territory of the  
23 United States; or**

24           **(b) The voluntary health care service provided is outside the  
25 scope of practice authorized by the professional license or  
26 certificate of the provider of health care.**

27       **3. A provider of health care who provides voluntary health  
28 care service pursuant to this section shall not accept compensation  
29 of any type, directly or indirectly, or any other benefit or  
30 consideration from any person or other source for the provision of  
31 the service.**

32       **Sec. 8. 1. A sponsoring organization shall, before  
33 organizing or arranging for the provision of voluntary health care  
34 service in this State, register with the Health Division by  
35 submitting to the Health Division a form prescribed by the Health  
36 Division which contains:**

37           **(a) The name, street address and telephone number of the  
38 sponsoring organization;**

39           **(b) The name, street address and telephone number of each  
40 person who is an officer, director or organizational official of the  
41 sponsoring organization and who is responsible for the operation  
42 of the sponsoring organization; and**

43           **(c) Any other information required for registration by the  
44 Health Division.**

45       **2. Each sponsoring organization shall:**



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1       (a) Notify the Health Division in writing of any change in the  
2 information required for registration pursuant to subsection 1 not  
3 later than 10 days after the change.

4       (b) File a report with the Health Division not later than 10  
5 days after the end of each calendar quarter identifying each  
6 provider of health care who provided voluntary health care service  
7 during the calendar quarter in association with the sponsoring  
8 organization. The report filed pursuant to this paragraph must  
9 include a copy of the current license or certificate of each provider  
10 of health care identified in the report and the date, location and  
11 type of service provided by each provider of health care. A  
12 sponsoring organization shall maintain a record of each report  
13 filed pursuant to this paragraph for a period of not less than 5  
14 years after the date on which the report is filed. Each report  
15 maintained pursuant to this paragraph, including copies thereof,  
16 must be made available for inspection by the Health Division upon  
17 reasonable request.

18       3. Compliance with this section shall be deemed to be prima  
19 facie evidence that a sponsoring organization has exercised due  
20 care in selecting a provider of health care to associate with the  
21 sponsoring organization to provide voluntary health care service.

22       4. The Health Division may, after reasonable notice and a  
23 hearing, revoke the registration of any sponsoring organization  
24 that fails to comply with the requirements of this section.

25       Sec. 9. The Health Division shall adopt regulations to carry  
26 out the provisions of sections 2 to 9, inclusive, of this act.

27       Sec. 10. NRS 629.031 is hereby amended to read as follows:

28       629.031 Except as otherwise provided by a specific statute:

29       1. "Provider of health care" means a physician licensed  
30 pursuant to chapter 630, 630A or 633 of NRS, physician assistant,  
31 dentist, licensed nurse, dispensing optician, optometrist, practitioner  
32 of respiratory care, registered physical therapist, podiatric physician,  
33 licensed psychologist, licensed marriage and family therapist,  
34 licensed clinical professional counselor, music therapist,  
35 chiropractor, athletic trainer, perfusionist, doctor of Oriental  
36 medicine in any form, medical laboratory director or technician,  
37 pharmacist, licensed dietitian or a licensed hospital as the employer  
38 of any such person.

39       2. For the purposes of NRS 629.051, 629.061, 629.065 and  
40 629.077, the term includes a facility that maintains the health care  
41 records of patients.

42       3. For the purposes of sections 2 to 9, inclusive, of this act,  
43 the term includes a person who holds a current license or  
44 certificate to practice his or her respective discipline pursuant to



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1       ***the applicable provisions of law of another state or territory of the***  
2       ***United States.***

3       **Sec. 11.** Chapter 690B of NRS is hereby amended by adding  
4 thereto a new section to read as follows:

5       ***Each policy of professional liability insurance delivered, issued***  
6       ***for delivery or renewed on or after October 1, 2013, must include***  
7       ***coverage for a practitioner who provides voluntary health care***  
8       ***service pursuant to sections 2 to 9, inclusive, of this act to the***  
9       ***extent that such coverage insures against any liability arising from***  
10      ***the provision of voluntary health care service by the insured***  
11      ***within the scope of his or her practice.***

12      **Sec. 12.** NRS 690B.200 is hereby amended to read as follows:

13      690B.200 As used in NRS 690B.200 to 690B.370, inclusive,  
14      ***and section 11 of this act,*** unless the context otherwise requires, the  
15      words and terms defined in NRS 690B.210 to 690B.240, inclusive,  
16      have the meanings ascribed to them in those sections.

17      **Sec. 13.** This act becomes effective:

18      1. Upon passage and approval for the purposes of adopting  
19      regulations and performing any other preparatory administrative  
20      tasks that are necessary to carry out the provisions of this act; and  
21      2. On October 1, 2013, for all other purposes.

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
