

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 447—COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS
(ON BEHALF OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION)

MARCH 25, 2013

SUMMARY—Revises provisions relating to roadside rest areas.
(BDR 35-1157)

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EXPLANATION – Matter in ***bolded italics*** is new; matter between brackets **[omitted material]** is material to be omitted.

AN ACT relating to highways; revising provisions relating to the construction, operation and maintenance of certain facilities to provide information and assistance to the traveling public; increasing fines for certain violations committed in roadside parks or rest areas; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

Existing law authorizes the Director of the Department of Transportation to designate appropriate locations for the construction of certain roadside facilities and signs which provide information to members of the traveling public concerning accommodations, food, fuel and recreation. (NRS 408.551, 408.553) Existing law allows such facilities or signs to be erected or constructed and maintained by the Department or by a city, county or other governmental agency or private person, under contract with the Department. (NRS 408.553) Federal law newly authorizes a state to allow the installation of signs that acknowledge the sponsorship of a rest area, and to allow a private party to operate limited commercial activities at a rest area. (23 U.S.C. §§ 111, 131) **Section 3** of this bill allows the Director of the Department, with the approval of the Board of Directors of the Department, to authorize a private person to erect or construct, sponsor, operate or maintain a facility or a sign at a rest area, under contract with the Department. **Section 4** of this bill makes conforming changes to the authorization of the Department to adopt regulations regarding such facilities and signs. (NRS 408.557)

Existing law makes it unlawful for any person, firm, corporation, association or other entity, other than a public utility, to sell, exhibit or offer for sale certain goods and services or to erect, place, post or maintain certain signs in any roadside park or safety rest area in this State. A person who violates that provision, or any regulation adopted governing roadside parks or safety rest areas, shall be punished by a fine of



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21 not more than \$100 for a first offense and not more than \$500 for each subsequent
22 offense. (NRS 408.433) **Section 1** of this bill raises the limit on a fine for a first
23 such offense to not more than \$1,000, and for each subsequent offense to not more
24 than \$5,000.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** NRS 408.433 is hereby amended to read as follows:
2 408.433 1. ~~If~~ *Except as otherwise provided in NRS*
3 **408.553, it** is unlawful for any person, firm, corporation, association
4 or other entity, other than a public utility, to:

5 (a) Sell, exhibit or offer for sale any goods, wares, products,
6 merchandise or services; or

7 (b) Erect, place, post or maintain any sign, billboard, placard,
8 notice or other form of advertising,

9 → in any roadside park or safety rest area in this state, or in the
10 approaches thereto.

11 2. Any person who violates any provision of this section or any
12 regulation adopted under this chapter governing roadside parks or
13 safety rest areas shall be punished by a fine of not more than ~~\$100~~
14 **\$1,000** for a first offense and not more than ~~\$500~~ **\$5,000** for each
15 subsequent offense.

16 **Sec. 2.** NRS 408.551 is hereby amended to read as follows:

17 408.551 As used in NRS 408.551 to 408.567, inclusive,
18 “center” means a facility, *including, without limitation, a safety*
19 *rest area*, to provide information *and services* to members of the
20 traveling public, concerning accommodations, food, fuel and
21 recreation, through an attendant or some *other* means of
22 communication.

23 **Sec. 3.** NRS 408.553 is hereby amended to read as follows:

24 408.553 1. The Director may designate appropriate locations
25 for the construction of centers and the erection and maintenance of
26 directional and informational signs within the right-of-way.

27 2. The signs or centers may be erected or constructed ~~and~~,
28 *sponsored, operated or* maintained by:

29 ~~(a)~~ The Department; ~~for~~

30 ~~(b)~~ A city, county or other governmental agency, ~~for private~~
31 ~~person~~, under contract with the Department ~~;~~ or

32 (c) *A private person under contract with the Department, if the*
33 *person has been authorized by the Director, with approval of the*
34 *Board, to enter into such a contract.*

35 **Sec. 4.** NRS 408.557 is hereby amended to read as follows:

36 408.557 1. The Director shall adopt regulations:



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1 (a) Governing the size, shape, lighting and other characteristics
2 of a sign to be erected at a location designated pursuant to
3 NRS 408.553;

4 (b) Authorizing the use of trademarks and symbols identifying
5 an individual enterprise on a sign erected at the location;

6 (c) Fixing the qualifications of a person or governmental agency
7 to **erect or construct**, operate , **sponsor or maintain** a center **or sign**
8 and of an enterprise to be identified on a directional or informational
9 sign;

10 (d) Fixing reasonable fees, based upon the market value as
11 determined by the Department, for:

12 (1) Authorizing the use of trademarks and symbols
13 identifying an individual enterprise on a directional or informational
14 sign; and

15 (2) Providing information **and assistance** concerning
16 commercial attractions and services; and

17 (e) Otherwise necessary to carry out the provisions of NRS
18 408.551 to 408.567, inclusive.

19 2. The regulations adopted by the Director pursuant to
20 subsection 1 must be consistent with the provisions of 23 U.S.C. ~~§§~~
21 **§§ 111 and** 131.

22 **Sec. 5.** NRS 408.559 is hereby amended to read as follows:

23 408.559 The Department shall develop a plan, in cooperation
24 with the Commission on Tourism, to carry out the provisions of
25 NRS 408.551 to 408.567, inclusive. The plan must take into
26 consideration such factors as:

27 1. Economic development in this state.

28 2. Availability of money for the purposes of NRS 408.551 to
29 408.567, inclusive.

30 3. Population in a particular area.

31 4. Proposed highway construction.

32 5. Need for information ~~H~~ **and services**.

33 → The Department and the Commission shall review the plan at
34 least once each year and revise it until the provisions of NRS
35 408.551 to 408.567, inclusive, have been uniformly put into effect
36 throughout the State.

37 **Sec. 6.** NRS 408.562 is hereby amended to read as follows:

38 408.562 The Director may recommend to the Board, for its
39 approval, programs to provide information **and services** to the
40 traveling public to be paid from such money as is available for this
41 purpose pursuant to NRS 408.567.

42 **Sec. 7.** NRS 408.563 is hereby amended to read as follows:

43 408.563 The Department may contract or enter into other
44 agreements with governmental agencies in this state or an adjoining
45 state or with private persons to study various systems of providing

2 construct, *sponsor, operate or maintain* signs which provide ~~that~~

4 **Sec. 8.** NRS 408.567 is hereby amended to read as follows:

5 408.567 1. Money received by the Department from:

6 (a) Fees for:

7 (1) Authorizing the use of trademarks and symbols
8 identifying an individual enterprise on a directional or informational
9 sign; and

10 (2) Providing information *and assistance* concerning
11 commercial attractions and services;

12 (b) Participants in a telephone system established to reserve
13 accommodations for travelers; and

14 (c) Appropriations made by the Legislature for the purposes of
15 NRS 408.551 to 408.567, inclusive,

16 → must be deposited with the State Treasurer for credit to the
17 Account for Systems of Providing Information to the Traveling
18 Public in the State Highway Fund, which is hereby created.

19 2. Money in the Account must only be used to carry out the
20 provisions of NRS 408.551 to 408.567, inclusive.

21 **Sec. 9.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2013.

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
