**SUMMARY**—Increases the maximum amount of the fee that the Director of the Department of Public Safety is required to establish for the Program for the Education of Motorcycle Riders. (BDR 43-1152)

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**AN ACT** relating to motorcycles; increasing the maximum amount of the fee that the Director of the Department of Public Safety is required to establish for the Program for the Education of Motorcycle Riders; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Legislative Counsel’s Digest:**

1 Under existing law, the Director of the Department of Public Safety is required  
2 to establish a Program for the Education of Motorcycle Riders, and approve courses  
3 of instruction provided by public or private organizations which comply with the  
4 requirements established for the Program. (NRS 486.372) Existing law provides  
5 that a resident of this State who holds a motorcycle driver’s license or a motorcycle  
6 endorsement to a driver’s license or who is eligible to apply for such a license or  
7 endorsement may enroll in the Program, and requires that the Director establish a  
8 fee for the Program of not more than \$100. (NRS 486.373) This bill increases the  
9 amount of the fee to not more than \$150.

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THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1       **Section 1.** NRS 486.373 is hereby amended to read as follows:  
2       486.373 1. A resident of this State who holds a motorcycle  
3 driver's license or a motorcycle endorsement to a driver's license or  
4 who is eligible to apply for such a license or endorsement may  
5 enroll in the Program.  
6       2. The Director shall establish a fee of not more than ~~100~~  
7 **\$150** for the Program.  
8       **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2013.

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
