SUMMARY—Urges the Office of the Governor to continue working with the Legislature to consider the potential impact of listing the greater sage grouse as an endangered or threatened species and to develop strategies to preclude the listing. (BDR R-207)

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ASSEMBLY CONCURRENT RESOLUTION—Urging the Office of the Governor to continue working with the Legislature to consider the potential impact of listing the greater sage grouse as an endangered or threatened species and to develop strategies to preclude the listing.

1 WHEREAS, The greater sage grouse (*Centrocercus*  
2 *urophasianus*) is a species of bird that inhabits much of the  
3 sagebrush habitat in Nevada as well as other western states; and

4 WHEREAS, Although the United States Fish and Wildlife  
5 Service has determined that the greater sage grouse is warranted for  
6 listing as endangered or threatened under the Endangered Species  
7 Act of 1973, 16 U.S.C. §§ 1531 et seq., listing the species is  
8 currently precluded by the need to take action on other species, and  
9 a proposed rule or change in determination as to listing the species  
10 must be made by the end of federal fiscal year 2015; and

11 WHEREAS, Through the enactment of Senate Concurrent  
12 Resolution No. 15, File Number 48, Statutes of Nevada 2005, at  
13 page 3022, the members of the 73rd Session of the Nevada  
14 Legislature found that the listing of the greater sage grouse as an  
15 endangered or threatened species would have a devastatingly



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1 negative impact on Nevada's land development, land use, water use,  
2 mining, recreational activities and local economies; and

3 WHEREAS, Through the enactment of Assembly Concurrent  
4 Resolution No. 3, File Number 25, Statutes of Nevada 2011, at page  
5 3833, the members of the 76th Session of the Nevada Legislature  
6 urged persons involved in activities to improve the population of the  
7 greater sage grouse and to prevent the greater sage grouse from  
8 being listed as an endangered or threatened species to engage in  
9 those activities in a proactive manner to ensure the protection and  
10 restoration of the population and habitat of the greater sage grouse;  
11 and

12 WHEREAS, Through the execution of Executive Order 2012-09,  
13 the Governor established the Governor's Greater Sage-grouse  
14 Advisory Committee to provide recommendations on policies and  
15 actions for developing a statewide strategy to preclude the need to  
16 list the greater sage grouse as endangered or threatened under the  
17 Endangered Species Act, and authorized the Advisory Committee to  
18 consult with members of the Nevada Legislature in developing its  
19 recommendations; and

20 WHEREAS, In accordance with Executive Order 2012-09, the  
21 Governor's Greater Sage-grouse Advisory Committee issued its  
22 report, "Strategic Plan for Conservation of Greater Sage-Grouse in  
23 Nevada," on July 31, 2012, and concluded its activities; now,  
24 therefore, be it

25 RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, THE  
26 SENATE CONCURRING, That the members of the 77th Session of the  
27 Nevada Legislature urge the Office of the Governor to continue the  
28 Legislature's involvement in:

29     1. Analyzing the potential economic impact of listing the  
30 greater sage grouse as an endangered or threatened species under the  
31 Endangered Species Act; and

32     2. Developing and implementing strategies to preclude the  
33 listing of the greater sage grouse as an endangered or threatened  
34 species under the Endangered Species Act; and be it further

35     RESOLVED, That the Chief Clerk of the Assembly prepare and  
36 transmit a copy of this resolution to the Governor; and be it further

37     RESOLVED, That this resolution becomes effective upon  
38 passage.
