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AN ACT making a supplemental appropriation to the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy of the Department of Health and Human Services for an unanticipated increase in caseloads for medical services and certain other costs; authorizing the expenditure of certain money for the same purposes; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1     **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General  
2 Fund to the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy of the  
3 Department of Health and Human Services the sum of \$26,912,908  
4 for an unanticipated increase in caseloads for medical services and  
5 costs per eligible recipient and unanticipated retroactive payments  
6 for Upper Payment Limit and Graduate Medical Education costs.  
7 This appropriation is supplemental to that made in section 18 of  
8 chapter 371, Statutes of Nevada 2011, at page 2158.



1       **Sec. 2.** Expenditure of \$82,863,609 not appropriated from the  
2 State General Fund or the State Highway Fund is hereby authorized  
3 during the fiscal years beginning on July 1, 2013, and ending on  
4 June 30, 2015, by the Division for the same purposes as set forth in  
5 section 1 of this act. This authorization is supplemental to the  
6 authorization made in section 1 of chapter 372, Statutes of Nevada  
7 2011, at page 2180.

8       **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.

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
