AN ACT relating to employment practices; repealing provisions governing certain employment practices concerning members of the Communist Party and related organizations; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Legislative Counsel’s Digest:**

1 Existing law requires the Legislative Counsel and the Research Director of the  
2 Legislative Counsel Bureau to work collaboratively to develop recommendations  
3 for the elimination of obsolete or antiquated provisions of the Nevada Revised  
4 Statutes. (NRS 220.085) This bill repeals an obsolete provision which excludes  
5 from the definition of the term “unlawful employment practice” any action or  
6 measure taken by an employer or certain entities against a person who is a member  
7 of the Communist Party or any other organization required to register as a  
8 Communist organization by order of the Subversive Activities Control Board  
9 pursuant to the Subversive Activities Control Act of 1950. (NRS 613.360; *see* 50  
10 U.S.C. §§ 781 et seq.)

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** NRS 613.360 is hereby repealed.

TEXT OF REPEALED SECTION

**613.360 Actions permitted against member of Communist Party or related organization.**

As used in NRS 613.310 to 613.435, inclusive, the phrase “unlawful employment practice” does not include any action or measure taken by an employer, labor organization, joint labor-management committee or employment agency with respect to an individual who is a member of the Communist Party of the United States or of any other organization required to register as a Communist-action or Communist-front organization by final order of the Subversive Activities Control Board pursuant to the Subversive Activities Control Act of 1950.
