AN ACT relating to municipal utilities; repealing a provision authorizing the use for general municipal purposes of net profits derived from municipal utilities owned and operated by certain incorporated cities; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

- 1      This bill repeals the existing law which authorizes an incorporated city having  
2      the commission form of government to use for general municipal purposes all net  
3      profits earned from any utility owned and operated by the city.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1      **Section 1.** NRS 710.600 is hereby repealed.  
2      **Sec. 2.** The provisions of section 1 of this act must not be  
3      applied in such a manner as to impair adversely any obligation  
4      outstanding on July 1, 2013.  
5      **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2013.

## TEXT OF REPEALED SECTION

---

**710.600 City having commission form of government may expend net profits from municipal utilities for general municipal purposes.** In any incorporated city having the commission form of government as defined by paragraph (b) of subsection 1 of NRS 267.010, all net profits derived from municipally owned and operated utilities may be expended, in the discretion of the governing body of such city, for general municipal purposes.
