SUMMARY—Revises provisions governing the issuance of special license plates for retired professional firefighters. (BDR 43-619)

AN ACT relating to special license plates; revising the provisions allowing issuance of a special license plate to certain applicants who are current or retired professional firefighters to include certain retired professional firefighters from other jurisdictions; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel’s Digest:

1 Under existing law, issuance of the special license plates that recognize current
2 or former employment as a professional full-time salaried firefighter is limited to
3 those firefighters who are: (1) employed as professional full-time salaried
4 firefighters in this State; or (2) retired from employment as professional full-time
5 salaried firefighters after completing at least 10 years of creditable service as
6 firefighters within this State. (NRS 482.3753) This bill allows the issuance of such
7 special license plates to any person who provides proof of retirement from
8 employment as a professional full-time salaried firefighter after completing at least
9 10 years of creditable service as a firefighter in any other jurisdiction in the United
10 States, including, without limitation, any city, county, state, territory, Indian tribe or
11 branch of the Armed Forces of the United States.



THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** NRS 482.3753 is hereby amended to read as
2 follows:

3 482.3753 1. Except as otherwise provided in this section, the
4 Department, in cooperation with professional full-time salaried
5 firefighters in the State of Nevada, shall design, prepare and issue
6 license plates that recognize current or former employment as a
7 professional full-time salaried firefighter using any colors and
8 designs which the Department deems appropriate. The Department
9 shall not design, prepare or issue the license plates unless it receives
10 at least 250 applications for the issuance of those plates.

11 2. The Department shall issue license plates that recognize
12 current or former employment as a professional full-time salaried
13 firefighter for a passenger car or a light commercial vehicle upon
14 application by a qualified person who is entitled to license plates
15 pursuant to NRS 482.265 and who otherwise complies with the
16 requirements for registration and licensing pursuant to this chapter.
17 A person may request that personalized prestige license plates
18 issued pursuant to NRS 482.3667 be combined with license plates
19 that recognize current or former employment as a professional full-
20 time salaried firefighter if that person pays the fees for the
21 personalized prestige license plates in addition to the fees for the
22 license plates that recognize current or former employment as a
23 professional full-time salaried firefighter.

24 3. An application for the issuance or renewal of license plates
25 that recognize current or former employment as a professional full-
26 time salaried firefighter is void unless it is accompanied by
27 documentation which, in the determination of the Department,
28 provides reasonable proof of the identity of the applicant and proof
29 of the applicant's:

30 (a) Current employment as a professional full-time salaried
31 firefighter; or

32 (b) Status as a former professional full-time salaried firefighter
33 who retired from employment after completing at least 10 years of
34 creditable service as a firefighter within this State *or any other*
35 *jurisdiction* with:

36 (1) A fire department; or

37 (2) A federal or state agency, the duties of which involve the
38 prevention and suppression of fires, including, without limitation,
39 the Bureau of Land Management and the Division of Forestry of the
40 State Department of Conservation and Natural Resources.

41 4. Proof of an applicant's current or former employment as a
42 professional full-time salaried firefighter must consist of:



- 1 (a) An identification card issued by the Professional Fire
2 Fighters of Nevada or its successor;
- 3 (b) An identification card issued by the Nevada Fire Chiefs
4 Association or its successor; ~~††~~
- 5 (c) *An identification card issued by a professional firefighters
6 or chiefs organization or association from any other jurisdiction
7 that is acceptable to the Department; or*
- 8 (d) A letter certifying the applicant's current or former
9 employment as a professional full-time salaried firefighter, which
10 letter must be from:
- 11 (1) The Professional Fire Fighters of Nevada or its successor;
- 12 (2) The Nevada Fire Chiefs Association or its successor; ~~††~~
- 13 (3) *A professional firefighters or chiefs organization or
14 association from any other jurisdiction that is acceptable to the
15 Department; or*
- 16 (4) The chief officer of a federal or state agency ~~††~~ *or any
17 other jurisdiction*, the duties of which involve the prevention and
18 suppression of fires, including, without limitation, the Bureau of
19 Land Management and the Division of Forestry of the State
20 Department of Conservation and Natural Resources.
- 21 5. The fee payable to the Department for license plates that
22 recognize current or former employment as a professional full-time
23 salaried firefighter is \$35, in addition to all other applicable
24 registration and license fees and governmental services taxes. The
25 license plates are renewable upon the payment to the Department of
26 \$10 in addition to all other applicable registration and license fees
27 and governmental services taxes.
- 28 6. In addition to all other applicable registration and license
29 fees and governmental services taxes and the fees prescribed in
30 subsection 5, a person who requests a set of license plates that
31 recognize current or former employment as a professional full-time
32 salaried firefighter must pay for the initial issuance of the plates an
33 additional fee of \$25 and for each renewal of the plates an additional
34 fee of \$20 to support the Professional Fire Fighters of Nevada
35 Benevolent Association.
- 36 7. The Department shall deposit the fees collected pursuant to
37 subsection 6 with the State Treasurer for credit to the State General
38 Fund. The State Treasurer shall, on a quarterly basis, distribute the
39 fees deposited pursuant to this subsection to the Professional Fire
40 Fighters of Nevada Benevolent Association.
- 41 8. If, during a registration period, the holder of license plates
42 issued pursuant to the provisions of this section disposes of the
43 vehicle to which the plates are affixed, the holder shall:



1 (a) Retain the plates and affix them to another vehicle that meets
2 the requirements of this section if the transfer and registration fees
3 are paid as set out in this chapter; or

4 (b) Within 30 days after removing the plates from the vehicle,
5 return them to the Department.

6 9. As used in this section ~~f, “professional”~~ :

7 (a) *“Any other jurisdiction” means any governmental or*
8 *quasi-governmental entity within the United States which employs*
9 *professional full-time salaried firefighters and includes, without*
10 *limitation, any city, county, state, territory, Indian tribe or branch*
11 *of the Armed Forces of the United States.*

12 (b) *“Professional full-time salaried firefighter” means a person*
13 *employed in this State or any other jurisdiction in a full-time*
14 *salaried occupation of fire fighting for the benefit or safety of the*
15 *public.*

16 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2015.
