AN ACT making a supplemental appropriation to the Department of Corrections for a shortfall resulting from a reduction in certain transfers for prison medical care; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General
2 Fund to the Department of Corrections the sum of \$1,193,577 for an
3 unanticipated shortfall in transfers from the Inmate Welfare Account
4 for prison medical care for Fiscal Year 2014-2015. This
5 appropriation is supplemental to that made in section 22 of chapter
6 446, Statutes of Nevada 2013, at page 2598.

7 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
