ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 469–COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

SUMMARY—Creating the Office of Finance in the Office of the Governor. (BDR 18-1180)

FISCAL NOTE: Effect on Local Government: No. Effect on the State: Yes.

EXPLANATION - Matter in *bolded italics* is new; matter between brackets [omitted material] is material to be omitted.

AN ACT relating to governmental administration; creating the Office of Finance in the Office of the Governor; transferring certain powers and duties of the Department of Administration to the Office of Finance; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

Existing law creates the Department of Administration consisting of several divisions, including the Budget Division and the Division of Internal Audits. (NRS 232.213) Section 2 of this bill creates the Office of Finance in the Office of the Governor. Sections 2-13 of this bill transfer the duties of the Budget Division and the Division of Internal Audits from the Department of Administration to the Office of Finance. Sections 14-16 of this bill provide transitory provisions regarding the transfer

Sections 14-16 of this bill provide transitory provisions regarding the transfer of the responsibilities of the Department of Administration to the Office of Finance, including the transfer and adoption of regulations, the effect of name changes on any existing contracts, revisions that may be necessary to other provisions of existing law and administrative regulations to conform to the changes made in this bill and other necessary direction to carry out the intent of this bill.

13 If this bill is enacted, the Legislative Counsel and the Legal Division of the 14 Legislative Counsel Bureau will be required by **section 16** and NRS 220.120 to 15 conform all sections of law not included in this bill to the reorganization provided 16 by this bill.





THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** Chapter 223 of NRS is hereby amended by adding 2 thereto the provisions set forth as sections 2 to 6, inclusive, of this 3 act.

4 Sec. 2. 1. The Office of Finance is hereby created in the 5 Office of the Governor.

6 2. The Office of Finance consists of a Director and the 7 following:

(a) The Budget Division; and

(b) The Division of Internal Audits.

10 Sec. 3. The Director of the Office of Finance:

11 1. Is appointed by, is responsible to and serves at the pleasure 12 of the Governor.

2. Is in the unclassified service of the State.

14 3. Shall not engage in any other gainful employment or 15 occupation.

16 Sec. 4. The Director of the Office of Finance:

17 1. Shall appoint a Chief of the Budget Division, or may serve 18 in this position if the Director has the qualifications required by 19 NRS 353.175.

20 2. Is responsible for the administration, through the divisions 21 of the Office, of the provisions of NRS 235.005 to 235.016, 22 inclusive, 353.150 to 353.246, inclusive, and 353A.031 to 23 353A.100, inclusive, and all other provisions of law relating to the 24 functions of the divisions of the Office.

25 Sec. 5. 1. The Director of the Office of Finance shall 26 appoint the Administrator of the Division of Internal Audits.

27 2. The Administrator of the Division of Internal Audits of the 28 Office of Finance serves at the pleasure of the Director and is in 29 the unclassified service of the State.

Unless federal law or regulation otherwise requires, 31 the Chief of the Budget Division and the Administrator of the 32 Division of Internal Audits may appoint a Deputy and a Chief 33 Assistant in the unclassified service of the State, who shall not 34 engage in any other gainful employment or occupation except as 35 otherwise provided in NRS 284.143.

28 **Sec. 15.** The assets and liabilities of any fund or account 29 transferred from the Director of the Department of Administration to 30 the Director of the Office of Finance are unaffected by the transfer.

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Sec. 16. The Legislative Counsel shall:

1. In preparing the Nevada Revised Statutes, use the authority set forth in subsection 10 of NRS 220.120 to substitute appropriately the name of any agency, officer or instrumentality of the State whose name is changed by this act for the name which the agency, officer or instrumentality previously used; and

2. In preparing supplements to the Nevada Administrative Code, substitute appropriately the name of any agency, officer or instrumentality of the State whose name is changed by this act for the name which the agency, officer or instrumentality previously used.
