ASSEMBLY RESOLUTION—Adding former Assemblyman Alan
H. Glover to the Assembly Wall of Distinction.

1 WHEREAS, The Assembly of the Legislature of the State of
2 Nevada has established a Wall of Distinction for those past
3 members of the Assembly selected by leadership who served with
4 great distinction and who made exemplary contributions to the State
5 of Nevada; and

6 WHEREAS, Alan H. Glover was born in 1949 in Carson City,
7 Nevada, to parents who held important positions in Nevada's
8 Executive Branch of State Government; and

9 WHEREAS, After receiving his bachelor of arts degree in
10 political science from the University of Nevada, Reno, Alan
11 returned to Carson City where he was a private insurance agent
12 early in his career; and

13 WHEREAS, Alan Glover, at 23 years of age, was elected to the
14 Nevada Assembly in 1972 where he represented Carson City and
15 served with distinction for the next 10 years until his election to the
16 Nevada Senate in November 1982; and

17 WHEREAS, Assemblyman Glover served in the Assembly during
18 an important period in history, which was marked by America's
19 Bicentennial in 1976, the end to the war in Vietnam, greatly
20 improved relations between the United States and China and
21 Nevada's emergence as the fastest growing state in the nation; and

22 WHEREAS, As a member of the Assembly, Alan Glover's
23 service was highlighted by 8 years on the Assembly Committee on
24 Ways and Means and his chairmanship of three standing
25 committees: the Assembly Committee on Transportation in 1973



1 and 1975, the Assembly Committee on Legislative Functions in
2 1977 and the Assembly Committee on Elections in 1981; and

3 WHEREAS, Assemblyman Glover was the primary sponsor of
4 numerous bills that were passed and signed into law, including
5 personal and committee bills, and served on interim study
6 committees that were indicative of his knowledge and expertise in
7 many diverse topics, including studies on data processing,
8 transportation, public housing, Nevada's judicial system, state
9 highway maintenance, driving under the influence laws, access to
10 public lands, state public works, local governments and workers'
11 compensation through private insurers; and

12 WHEREAS, Following his service in the Assembly, Alan served
13 3 years in the Senate until his appointment as Carson City Recorder
14 in 1985 where he would continue to serve in that office, which later
15 became the elected office of Carson City Clerk-Recorder, until his
16 retirement in December 2014, thus giving the people of Nevada and
17 his community a total of 38 years of quality elective service; and

18 WHEREAS, Alan Glover was honored with his appointment in
19 November 2011 by the First Judicial District Court to serve as one
20 of three Special Masters who prepared a nonpartisan plan of
21 redistricting for the Representatives of Nevada's Congressional
22 Delegation and the members of the Nevada State Legislature, a plan
23 that remains in effect today; now, therefore, be it

24 RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, That,
25 for his 10 years of dedicated service to the Assembly and 28 years
26 of service as a highly respected elected public officer of this State,
27 former Assemblyman Alan H. Glover is hereby added to the Nevada
28 Assembly Wall of Distinction; and be it further

29 RESOLVED, That the Chief Clerk of the Assembly prepare and
30 transmit a copy of this resolution to former Assemblyman Alan H.
31 Glover.
