SUMMARY—Revises provisions governing motor vehicles.
(BDR 43-718)

AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; revising the definition of a trimobile; revising provisions governing the Account for the Program for the Education of Motorcycle Riders; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

- 1 Existing law defines a trimobile to mean a motor vehicle designed to travel
- 2 with three wheels on the ground, two of which are power driven. (NRS 482.129,
- 3 486.057) **Sections 3.3 and 3.7** of this bill revise the definition of a trimobile to
- 4 provide that at least one of the wheels must be power driven and excludes from the
- 5 definition a motorcycle with a sidecar.
- 6 Existing law provides for an Account for the Program for the Education of
- 7 Motorcycle Riders and authorizes the use of money from the Account to pay the
- 8 expenses of the Program for the Education of Motorcycle Riders or for any other
- 9 purpose authorized by the Legislature. (NRS 486.372) **Section 4.5** of this bill
- 10 removes the provision allowing money from the Account to be used for any other
- 11 purpose authorized by the Legislature.

2 **Sec. 3.3.** NRS 482.129 is hereby amended to read as follows:

3 482.129 “Trimobile” means every motor vehicle designed to
4 travel with three wheels in contact with the ground, ~~[two]~~ *at least*
5 *one* of which ~~[are]~~ *is* power driven. *The term does not include a*
6 *motorcycle with a sidecar.*

7 **Sec. 3.7.** NRS 486.057 is hereby amended to read as follows:

8 486.057 “Trimobile” means every motor vehicle designed to
9 travel with three wheels in contact with the ground, ~~[two]~~ *at least*
10 *one* of which ~~[are]~~ *is* power driven. *The term does not include a*
11 *motorcycle with a sidecar.*

12 **Sec. 4.** (Deleted by amendment.)

13 **Sec. 4.5.** NRS 486.372 is hereby amended to read as follows:

14 486.372 1. The Director shall:

15 (a) Establish the Program for the Education of Motorcycle
16 Riders.

17 (b) Appoint an Administrator to carry out the Program.

18 (c) Consult regularly with the Advisory Board on Motorcycle
19 Safety concerning the content and implementation of the Program.

20 (d) Approve courses of instruction provided by public or private
21 organizations which comply with the requirements established for
22 the Program.

23 (e) Adopt rules and regulations which are necessary to carry out
24 the Program.

25 2. The Director may contract for the provision of services
26 necessary for the Program.

27 3. The Account for the Program for the Education of
28 Motorcycle Riders is hereby created in the State General Fund. The
29 Director shall administer the Account.

30 4. The money in the Account for the Program for the Education
31 of Motorcycle Riders may *only* be used ~~for~~

32 ~~—(a) To~~ *to* pay the expenses of the Program, including
33 reimbursement to instructors licensed pursuant to NRS 486.375 for
34 services provided for the Program. ~~for~~ *or*

35 ~~—(b) For any other purpose authorized by the Legislature.]~~

36 5. The interest and income earned on the money in the
37 Account, after deducting any applicable charges, must be credited to
38 the Account.

39 6. Any money remaining in the Account for the Program for
40 the Education of Motorcycle Riders at the end of a fiscal year does
41 not revert to the State General Fund, and the balance in the Account
42 must be carried forward to the next fiscal year.
