AN ACT making a supplemental appropriation to the State Distributive School Account for a shortfall resulting from an unanticipated increase in K-12 enrollment for the 2013-2014 and 2014-2015 school years; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General  
2 Fund to the State Distributive School Account created by NRS  
3 387.030 the sum of \$62,026,744 for a shortfall resulting from an  
4 unanticipated increase in K-12 enrollment for the 2013-2014 and  
5 2014-2015 school years. This appropriation is supplemental to that  
6 made by section 4 of chapter 382, Statutes of Nevada 2013, at page  
7 2056.

8 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
