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AN ACT relating to state purchasing; providing for the disposition  
of rebates for purchases made with procurement cards;  
and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Legislative Counsel’s Digest:**

1 This bill provides for the disposition of money received by the State in the form  
2 of rebates for purchases made by using charge cards issued to state agencies or their  
3 authorized representatives, commonly known as “procurement cards.” Under the  
4 provisions of this bill, after deducting administrative costs: (1) 50 percent of any  
5 such rebate is deposited into the Account to Stabilize the Operation of the State  
6 Government, also known as the Rainy Day Fund; and (2) the other 50 percent is  
7 given to the state agency that made the purchase. Such money deposited into the  
8 Rainy Day Fund must not be used to replace or supplant funding from other  
9 sources. Also, such money received by a state agency: (1) must not be used to  
10 replace or supplant funding available from other sources; and (2) may be used at  
11 the discretion of the head of the agency.

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THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** Chapter 333 of NRS is hereby amended by adding  
2 thereto a new section to read as follows:

3 *1. Any money provided to the State in the form of a rebate for*  
4 *a purchase made with a procurement card must, after deducting*  
5 *administrative costs, be distributed as follows:*



1       (a) *Fifty percent deposited into the Account to Stabilize the*  
2 *Operation of the State Government created pursuant to NRS*  
3 *353.288; and*

4       (b) *Fifty percent given to the using agency that made the*  
5 *purchase.*

6       2. *The money:*

7       (a) *Deposited into the Account to Stabilize the Operation of the*  
8 *State Government pursuant to subsection 1 must not be used to*  
9 *replace or supplant funding available from other sources.*

10       (b) *Received by a using agency pursuant to subsection 1:*

11       (1) *Must not be used to replace or supplant funding*  
12 *available from other sources; and*

13       (2) *May be used at the discretion of the head of the using*  
14 *agency.*

15       3. *As used in this section, "procurement card" means a*  
16 *charge card issued to a using agency or its authorized*  
17 *representative for the purchase of goods and services pursuant to*  
18 *the provisions of this chapter.*

19       **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2017.
