

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 225—ASSEMBLYMAN CARRILLO

SUMMARY—Revises provisions governing the time for the commencement of a school day for public high schools. (BDR 34-537)

AN ACT relating to education; requiring a school district to set the time for the commencement of a school day for a public high school; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel’s Digest:

1 Existing law provides that a high school is a public school in which subjects
2 above the eighth grade may be taught. (NRS 388.020) Existing law also requires
3 the board of trustees of a school district to schedule and provide a minimum of 180
4 days of free school in the district under its charge. (NRS 388.090) This bill requires
5 each school district to set the time for commencement of the school day which must
6 not be earlier than 9 a.m. for a high school.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** Chapter 388 of NRS is hereby amended by adding
2 thereto a new section to read as follows:

3 *Each school district shall set the time for the commencement of*
4 *the school day which must not be earlier than 9 a.m. for a high*
5 *school.*

6 **Sec. 2.** The provisions of NRS 354.599 do not apply to any
7 additional expenses of a local government that are related to the
8 provisions of this act.



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- 1 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective:
2 1. Upon passage and approval for the purposes of performing
3 any preparatory administrative tasks that are necessary to carry out
4 the provisions of this act; and
5 2. On July 1, 2017, for all other purposes.
