SUMMARY—Revises provisions governing the time for the commencement of a school day for public high schools. (BDR 34-537)

AN ACT relating to education; requiring a school district to set the time for the commencement of a school day for a public high school; and providing other matters properly relating thereto

**Legislative Counsel's Digest:** 

Existing law provides that a high school is a public school in which subjects above the eighth grade may be taught. (NRS 388.020) Existing law also requires the board of trustees of a school district to schedule and provide a minimum of 180 days of free school in the district under its charge. (NRS 388.090) This bill requires each school district to set the time for commencement of the school day which must not be earlier than 9 a.m. for a high school.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** Chapter 388 of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

Each school district shall set the time for the commencement of the school day which must not be earlier than 9 a.m. for a high school.

**Sec. 2.** The provisions of NRS 354.599 do not apply to any additional expenses of a local government that are related to the provisions of this act.
