

SENATE BILL NO. 215—SENATORS WOODHOUSE, MANENDO,  
PARKS, SPEARMAN, CANCELA; CANNIZZARO, DENIS, FORD,  
RATTI AND SEGERBLOM

FEBRUARY 27, 2017

Referred to Committee on Transportation

SUMMARY—Revises the circumstances under which the holder of a driver’s license or identification card must report a name change to the Department of Motor Vehicles. (BDR 43-673)

FISCAL NOTE: Effect on Local Government: Increases or Newly Provides for Term of Imprisonment in County or City Jail or Detention Facility.  
Effect on the State: Yes.

AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; revising the circumstances under which the holder of a driver’s license or identification card must report a name change to the Department of Motor Vehicles; enacting provisions authorizing the holder of a driver’s license or identification card to request a name change upon the occurrence of certain events; providing a penalty; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Legislative Counsel’s Digest:**

1 Existing law requires an applicant for a driver’s license, instruction permit,  
2 driver authorization card, identification card or motorcycle driver’s license to state  
3 on the application his or her full legal name, and to furnish proof of his or her full  
4 legal name and age. (NRS 483.290, 483.291, 483.850, 483.860, 486.081) The  
5 Director of the Department of Motor Vehicles is required to define by regulation  
6 the term “full legal name” as the term is used in relation to driver’s licenses,  
7 instruction permits, driver authorization cards, identification cards and motorcycle  
8 driver’s licenses. (NRS 481.052) A holder of a driver’s license or identification  
9 card must report to the Department within 30 days if the holder’s name changes.  
10 (NRS 483.390, 483.870) The Department is authorized to charge a fee for such a  
11 name change. (NRS 483.410, 483.820)

12 **Section 3** of this bill removes the requirement for the Director of the  
13 Department to define the term “full legal name.” **Section 1** of this bill instead  
14 defines the term “full legal name” for the purposes of the sections governing  
15 driver’s licenses, instruction permits, driver authorization cards, identification cards  
16 and motorcycle driver’s licenses. **Sections 12 and 18** of this bill remove the  
17 requirement to report a name change to the Department within 30 days. That  
18 requirement is similarly reenacted in **section 5** of this bill, which requires a person  
19 to request a change of his or her full legal name on a driver’s license, including a  
20 motorcycle driver’s license, after a legal change of the person’s name in accordance  
21 with a court order, certificate of marriage or a decree of divorce or adoption. The  
22 person must submit to the Department an original or certified copy of the order,  
23 certificate or decree which indicates the name change. **Section 5** also allows a  
24 person whose name has not been legally changed in accordance with an order,  
25 certificate or decree to request a change of his or her full legal name upon adoption,  
26 marriage, divorce or the death of a spouse. The person is required to include an  
27 original or a certified copy of the certificate or decree evidencing the applicable  
28 event and must also provide an affidavit indicating the person’s choice of how his  
29 or her name is to be changed. The authority of the Department to charge a fee for  
30 the name change is retained. **Section 6** of this bill makes similar changes for the  
31 holder of an identification card. Existing law makes a violation of **section 5** a  
32 misdemeanor. (NRS 483.530, 483.620) **Sections 7-9, 13 and 15** of this bill make  
33 conforming changes.

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THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN

1 **Section 1.** NRS 481.015 is hereby amended to read as follows:  
2 481.015 1. Except as otherwise provided in this subsection,

5 that identifies the legal owner of a vehicle and contains the

13 (a) “Department” means the Department of Motor Vehicles.

14 (b) “Director” means the Director of the Department.

16 *natural person’s first name, middle name and family name or last*  
17 *name, without the use of initials or a nickname. The term includes*  
18 *a full legal name that has been changed pursuant to the provisions*  
19 *of section 5 or 6 of this act.*

14 *a certificate of marriage and an original or certified copy of a*

18 *used before the marriage; or*

18 483.020 As used in NRS 483.010 to 483.630, inclusive, *and*  
19 *section 5 of this act*, unless the context otherwise requires, the  
20 words and terms defined in NRS 483.030 to 483.190, inclusive,  
21 have the meanings ascribed to them in those sections.

23 483.220 The Administrator is authorized to promulgate rules

27 483.290 1. An application for an instruction permit or for a  
28 driver's license must:

32 administer those oaths without charge.

33 (c) Be accompanied by the required fee.

34 (d) State the full legal name, date of birth, sex, address of  
35 principal residence and mailing address, if different from the  
36 address of principal residence, of the applicant and briefly describe

39 driver, and, if so, when and by what state or country, and whether  
40 any such license has ever been suspended or revoked, or whether an

44 require to determine the competency and eligibility of the applicant.



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1 2. Every applicant must furnish proof of his or her full legal  
2 name and age by displaying:

3 (a) An original or certified copy of the required documents as  
4 prescribed by regulation; or

5 (b) A photo identification card issued by the Department of  
6 Corrections pursuant to NRS 209.511.

7 3. The Department shall adopt regulations prescribing the  
8 documents an applicant may use to furnish proof of his or her full  
9 legal name and age to the Department pursuant to paragraph (a) of  
10 subsection 2 ~~H~~, ***including, without limitation, a document issued***  
11 ***by the Department pursuant to section 5 or 6 of this act.***

12 4. At the time of applying for a driver's license, an applicant  
13 may, if eligible, register to vote pursuant to NRS 293.524.

14 5. Every applicant who has been assigned a social security  
15 number must furnish proof of his or her social security number by  
16 displaying:

17 (a) An original card issued to the applicant by the Social  
18 Security Administration bearing the social security number of the  
19 applicant; or

20 (b) Other proof acceptable to the Department, including, without  
21 limitation, records of employment or federal income tax returns.

22 6. The Department may refuse to accept a driver's license  
23 issued by another state, the District of Columbia or any territory of  
24 the United States if the Department determines that the other state,  
25 the District of Columbia or the territory of the United States has less  
26 stringent standards than the State of Nevada for the issuance of a  
27 driver's license.

28 7. With respect to any document presented by a person who  
29 was born outside of the United States to prove his or her full legal  
30 name and age, the Department:

31 (a) May, if the document has expired, refuse to accept the  
32 document or refuse to issue a driver's license to the person  
33 presenting the document, or both; and

34 (b) Shall issue to the person presenting the document a driver's  
35 license that is valid only during the time the applicant is authorized  
36 to stay in the United States, or if there is no definite end to the time  
37 the applicant is authorized to stay, the driver's license is valid for 1  
38 year beginning on the date of issuance.

39 8. The Administrator shall adopt regulations setting forth  
40 criteria pursuant to which the Department will issue or refuse to  
41 issue a driver's license in accordance with this section to a person  
42 who is a citizen of any state, the District of Columbia, any territory  
43 of the United States or a foreign country. The criteria pursuant to  
44 which the Department shall issue or refuse to issue a driver's license



1 to a citizen of a foreign country must be based upon the purpose for  
2 which that person is present within the United States.

3 9. Notwithstanding any other provision of this section, the  
4 Department shall not accept a consular identification card as proof  
5 of the age or identity of an applicant for an instruction permit or for  
6 a driver's license. As used in this subsection, "consular  
7 identification card" has the meaning ascribed to it in NRS 232.006.

8 **Sec. 11.** NRS 483.291 is hereby amended to read as follows:

9 483.291 1. An application for an instruction permit or for a  
10 driver authorization card must:

11 (a) Be made upon a form furnished by the Department.

12 (b) Be verified by the applicant before a person authorized to  
13 administer oaths. Officers and employees of the Department may  
14 administer those oaths without charge.

15 (c) Be accompanied by the required fee.

16 (d) State the name, date of birth, sex and residence address of  
17 the applicant and briefly describe the applicant.

18 (e) State whether the applicant has theretofore been licensed as a  
19 driver, and, if so, when and by what state or country, and whether  
20 any such license has ever been suspended or revoked, or whether an  
21 application has ever been refused, and, if so, the date of and reason  
22 for the suspension, revocation or refusal.

23 (f) Include such other information as the Department may  
24 require to determine the competency and eligibility of the applicant.

25 2. Every applicant must furnish proof of his or her name and  
26 age by displaying an original or certified copy of:

27 (a) Any one of the following documents:

28 (1) A birth certificate issued by a state, a political subdivision  
29 of a state, the District of Columbia or any territory of the United  
30 States;

31 (2) A driver's license issued by another state, the District of  
32 Columbia or any territory of the United States which is issued  
33 pursuant to the standards established by 6 C.F.R. Part 37, Subparts  
34 A to E, inclusive, and which contains a security mark approved by  
35 the United States Department of Homeland Security in accordance  
36 with 6 C.F.R. § 37.17;

37 (3) A passport issued by the United States Government;

38 (4) A military identification card or military dependent  
39 identification card issued by any branch of the Armed Forces of the  
40 United States;

41 (5) For persons who served in any branch of the Armed  
42 Forces of the United States, a report of separation;

43 (6) A Certificate of Degree of Indian Blood issued by the  
44 United States Government;





1 (7) A Certificate of Citizenship, Certificate of Naturalization,  
2 Permanent Resident Card or Temporary Resident Card issued by the  
3 United States Citizenship and Immigration Services of the  
4 Department of Homeland Security;

5 (8) A Consular Report of Birth Abroad issued by the  
6 Department of State; ~~for~~

7 (9) *A document issued by the Department pursuant to*  
8 *section 5 or 6 of this act; or*

9 (10) Such other documentation as specified by the  
10 Department by regulation; or

11 (b) Any two of the following documents:

12 (1) A driver's license issued by another state, the District of  
13 Columbia or any territory of the United States other than such a  
14 driver's license described in subparagraph (2) of paragraph (a);

15 (2) A passport issued by a foreign government;

16 (3) A birth certificate issued by a foreign government;

17 (4) A consular identification card issued by the Government  
18 of Mexico or a document issued by another government that the  
19 Department determines is substantially similar; or

20 (5) Any other proof acceptable to the Department.

21 ➔ No document which is written in a language other than English  
22 may be accepted by the Department pursuant to this subsection  
23 unless it is accompanied by a verified translation of the document in  
24 the English language.

25 3. Every applicant must prove his or her residence in this State  
26 by displaying an original or certified copy of any two of the  
27 following documents:

28 (a) A receipt from the rent or lease of a residence located in this  
29 State;

30 (b) A record from a public utility for a service address located in  
31 this State which is dated within the previous 60 days;

32 (c) A bank or credit card statement indicating a residential  
33 address located in this State which is dated within the previous 60  
34 days;

35 (d) A stub from an employment check indicating a residential  
36 address located in this State;

37 (e) A document issued by an insurance company or its agent,  
38 including, without limitation, an insurance card, binder or bill,  
39 indicating a residential address located in this State;

40 (f) A record, receipt or bill from a medical provider indicating a  
41 residential address located in this State; or

42 (g) Any other document as prescribed by the Department by  
43 regulation.



1 4. Except as otherwise provided in subsection 5, a driver  
2 authorization card or instruction permit obtained in accordance with  
3 this section must:

4 (a) Contain the same information as prescribed for a driver's  
5 license pursuant to NRS 483.340 and any regulations adopted  
6 pursuant thereto;

7 (b) Be of the same design as a driver's license and contain only  
8 the minimum number of changes from that design that are necessary  
9 to comply with subsection 5; and

10 (c) Be numbered from the same sequence of numbers as a  
11 driver's license.

12 5. A driver authorization card or instruction permit obtained in  
13 accordance with this section must comply with the requirements of  
14 section 202(d)(11) of the Real ID Act of 2005, Public Law 109-13,  
15 Division B, Title II, 119 Stat. 302, 312-15, 49 U.S.C. § 30301 note.

16 6. Notwithstanding the provisions of NRS 483.380, every  
17 driver authorization card expires on the anniversary of its issuance  
18 or renewal. Every driver authorization card is renewable at any time  
19 before its expiration upon application and payment of the required  
20 fee. The Department may, by regulation, defer the expiration of the  
21 driver authorization card of a person who is on active duty in the  
22 Armed Forces of the United States upon such terms and conditions  
23 as it may prescribe. The Department may similarly defer the  
24 expiration of the driver authorization card of the spouse or  
25 dependent son or daughter of that person if the spouse or child is  
26 residing with the person.

27 7. A driver authorization card shall not be used to determine  
28 eligibility for any benefits, licenses or services issued or provided by  
29 this State or its political subdivisions.

30 8. Except as otherwise provided in this section or by specific  
31 statute, any provision of this title that applies to drivers' licenses  
32 shall be deemed to apply to a driver authorization card and an  
33 instruction permit obtained in accordance with this section.

34 **Sec. 12.** NRS 483.390 is hereby amended to read as follows:

35 483.390 Whenever any person after applying for or receiving a  
36 driver's license moves from the address named in the application or  
37 in the license issued to the person, ~~for when the name of a licensee  
38 is changed,~~ that person shall within 30 days thereafter notify the  
39 Department of his or her new and old addresses ~~[- or of such former  
40 and new names,]~~ and of the number of any license then held by the  
41 person.

6 (c) To lend his or her driver's license to any other person or  
7 knowingly permit the use thereof by another;

8 (d) To display or represent as one's own any driver's license not  
9 issued to him or her;

10 (e) To fail or refuse to surrender to the Department, a peace  
11 officer or a court upon lawful demand any driver's license which  
12 has been suspended, revoked or cancelled;

23 2. Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, a person  
24 who uses a false or fictitious name in any application for a driver's  
25 license or identification card or who knowingly makes a false  
26 statement or knowingly conceals a material fact or otherwise  
27 commits a fraud in any such application is guilty of a category E  
28 felony and shall be punished as provided in NRS 193.130. If the  
29 false statement, knowing concealment of a material fact or other  
30 commission of fraud described in this subsection relates solely to  
31 the age of a person, including, without limitation, to establish false  
32 proof of age to game, purchase alcoholic beverages or purchase  
33 cigarettes or other tobacco products, the person is guilty of a  
34 misdemeanor.

35 **Sec. 14.** NRS 483.620 is hereby amended to read as follows:

36 483.620 It is a misdemeanor for any person to violate any of  
37 the provisions of NRS 483.010 to 483.630, inclusive, *and section 5*  
38 *of this act*, unless such violation is, by NRS 483.010 to 483.630,  
39 inclusive, *and section 5 of this act* or other law of this State,  
40 declared to be a felony.

41 **Sec. 15.** NRS 483.820 is hereby amended to read as follows:

42 483.820 1. A person who applies for an identification card in
