SUMMARY—Revises the membership of the Nevada State Board on Geographic Names. (BDR 26-127)

AN ACT relating to the Nevada State Board on Geographic Names; adding a representative of the United States National Park Service to the Board; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel’s Digest:

1 Under existing law, the Nevada State Board on Geographic Names coordinates
2 and approves geographic names within the State for official recommendation to the
3 United States Board on Geographic Names. (NRS 327.110) The Nevada State
4 Board on Geographic Names consists of representatives from various state and
5 federal agencies and organizations and the Inter-Tribal Council of Nevada, Inc.
6 (NRS 327.120) This bill revises the composition of the Board by adding a
7 representative from the United States National Park Service to the current
8 membership of the Board.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** NRS 327.120 is hereby amended to read as follows:
2 327.120 The Board consists of:
3 1. One representative of each of the following agencies or
4 organizations:
5 (a) Bureau of Mines and Geology of the State of Nevada.



- 1 (b) Faculty of the University of Nevada, Reno.
- 2 (c) Faculty of the University of Nevada, Las Vegas.
- 3 (d) *Division of* State Library, Archives and Public Records **H** *of*
- 4 *the Department of Administration.*
- 5 (e) Department of Transportation of the State.
- 6 (f) State Department of Conservation and Natural Resources.
- 7 (g) Nevada Historical Society.
- 8 (h) United States Bureau of Land Management.
- 9 (i) United States Forest Service.
- 10 (j) *United States National Park Service.*
- 11 (k) Inter-Tribal Council of Nevada, Inc. , *or its successor*
- 12 *organization.*
- 13 ↪ Each agency or organization shall designate a representative and
- 14 one alternative representative for this purpose.
- 15 2. An Executive Secretary who is a nonvoting member of the
- 16 Board. The State Resident Cartographer shall serve in this position.
- 17 If there is not such a cartographer, the voting members of the Board
- 18 shall select the Executive Secretary.
- 19 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
