PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE BOARD OF WILDLIFE COMMISSIONERS

COMMISSION GENERAL REGULATION 276

Authority: NRS 501.181, and 501.243

Notice of Intent: August 11, 1999 Commission Approval:

EXPLANATION: Amends NAC 501.165 by adding a provision which establishes that a hearing on

appeal will he held by the Commission within 60 days of receipt of a request for hearing unless

otherwise extended.

NOTE: Matter in *italics* is new; matter within brackets \vdash is to be omitted.

Section 1. NAC 501.165 is hereby amended to read as follows:

501.165 1. Except as otherwise provided in subsection 2, a hearing regarding a denial, revocation or

suspension of a license or permit ordered pursuant to the provisions of chapters 501 through 506,

inclusive, of NRS and any regulations adopted pursuant to those chapters will be conducted by the

commission as a hearing de novo at the next available meeting of the commission or within

60 days of receipt of the request for hearing, whichever occurs first unless otherwise

extended by stipulation of the parties.

2. At a hearing conducted pursuant to NRS 501.1816, the commission will:

(a) Allow to be presented only evidence that is in the record regarding the suspension or

revocation of the license, permit or privilege that is on file with the division; and

(b) Consider only allegations of procedural error committed by the division.
