EXPLANATON: The proposed regulation revises the duties of the Secretary of the Commission to report the money available in the Wildlife Heritage Account available for expenditure.

Section 1. NAC 501.330 Is hereby amended to read as follows:

501.330 1. On or before November 1 of each year, the Secretary of the Commission shall make available to the public the application form described in NAC 501.300.

2. On or before the first meeting of the Commission after January 31 of each year, the Secretary of the Commission shall provide to the Commission an accounting of 75 percent of the money deposited and the total amount of the interest earned on the Account during the previous year.
