AUTHORITY: Chapter 482 of the Nevada Revised Statutes

A REGULATION relating to use of a disclosure form to be used when a seller of a vehicle exercises a valid option to cancel the sale of a vehicle to a customer; form of the disclosure prescribed by the Department of Motor Vehicles.

Section 1. NAC 482.XXX is hereby amended to read as follows:

482.XXX Disclosure form to be used by dealer

1. A seller of a motor vehicle shall utilize a disclosure form as prescribed by the Department whenever a dealer exercises a valid option to cancel the sale of a vehicle to a customer. The form shall be completed by both the dealer and customer before they may enter into a new agreement for the sale of the same vehicle on different terms, or for the sale of another vehicle. A disclosure for the cancellation of the sale of an automobile shall be made upon a form supplied by the department.

The form shall contain but not be limited to:

- 1. A section containing the original and renegotiated terms for the sale of a vehicle
- 2. A section for the new vehicle information if the original vehicle is not to be purchased
- 3. Year, Make and Vehicle Identification number of the vehicle
- 4. Seller and buyer information
- 5. Terms of the sale
- 6. A section containing a hand written statement of understanding from the customer

- (a) That he is not obligated to accept the original vehicle under different terms
- (b) That he may return the vehicle and receive any down payment or trade in or any other consideration
