**PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE
COMMISSIONER OF INSURANCE**

**NOTICE OF WORKSHOP TO SOLICIT COMMENTS ON
PROPOSED REGULATIONS**

The State of Nevada Department of Business and Industry, Division of Insurance ("Division"), (775) 687-4270, is proposing the amendment of regulations pertaining to **chapters 616B, 679B, 680A and 682A** of the Nevada Administrative Code ("NAC"). A workshop has been set for **9:00 a.m. on November 7, 2008**, at the offices of the Division, **788 Fairview Drive, Suite 300, Carson City, Nevada 89701**. Interested parties may also participate through a simultaneous video-conference conducted at the Bradley Building, 2501 East Sahara Avenue, Real Estate Division Conference Room, 2nd Floor, Las Vegas, Nevada 89104. The purpose of the workshop is to solicit comments from interested persons on the following general topics that may be addressed in the proposed regulations.

Consolidated Insurance Program Loss Experience. The proposed regulation will amend chapter 616B of the NAC by adding thereto a new section relating to the allocation of the industrial insurance loss experience under consolidated insurance programs. This regulation is to implement the provisions of Senate Bill 99 of the 74th Legislative Session (2007).

Expense Reference Correction. The proposed regulation will amend NAC 679B.0335 to update references from which information concerning reimbursement of rates may be obtained.

Efficient Filing Requirements. The proposed regulation will amend NAC 680A.160 by revising provisions relating to the filing of annual statements to eliminate the requirement that foreign or alien insurers file affidavits or jurats with the Commissioner of Insurance when statements are filed electronically with the National Association of Insurance Commissioners ("NAIC").

Model Audit Rule. The proposed regulation concerning financial reporting will amend chapter 680A of the NAC by adding provisions and amending certain sections relating to the annual audited financial reports. NAC 680A is being amended in order for the Division of Insurance to meet the Financial Regulation Standards and Accreditation Program of the NAIC.

Updating Price of Manual. The proposed regulation will amend chapter 682A of the NAC by updating provisions relating to the cost of obtaining a copy of a certain publication of the NAIC.

NOTICE OF INTENT TO ACT UPON REGULATION

Notice of Hearing for the Amendment of Regulations of the Department of Business and Industry, Division of Insurance

The Department of Business and Industry, Division of Insurance (“Division”), will hold a public hearing at **9:00 a.m. on November 21, 2008**, at the offices of the Division, 788 Fairview Drive, Suite 300, Carson City, Nevada 89701. Interested persons may also participate through a simultaneous video-conference conducted at the Bradley Building, 2501 East Sahara Avenue, Real Estate Division Conference Room, 2nd Floor, Las Vegas, Nevada 89104. The purpose of the hearing is to receive comments from all interested persons regarding the amendment of the regulation that pertains to **chapter 680A** of the Nevada Administrative Code (“NAC”).

The following information is provided pursuant to the requirements of NRS 233B.0603:

1. The need for and the purpose of the proposed regulation or amendment.

The proposed amendment to NAC 680A.160(3) enhances the efficiency of processing the annual statements of Nevada licensed foreign or alien insurers pursuant to NRS 680A.270. This is accomplished by eliminating the requirement of filing statements or jurats with the State of Nevada Division of Insurance, replacing the filing instead with strict reliance upon the filing made with the National Association of Insurance Commissioners (“NAIC”). This change would not apply to those foreign or alien insurers which do not file annual or quarterly financial statements with the NAIC.

2. Either the terms or substance of the regulation to be adopted, amended or repealed, or a description of the subject and issues involved.

The proposed amendment to NAC 680A.160(3) sets forth that, if a foreign or alien insurer files a statement in an electronic format with the NAIC, that statement will be deemed to have been filed with the Commissioner if the foreign or alien insurer has paid the applicable fees set forth in NRS 680B.010.

3. A statement of the estimated economic effect of the regulation on the business it is to regulate and on the public, as follows:

Both adverse and beneficial effects: The proposed amendment is expected to generate minor cost savings to insurers, and indirectly to the public, of not less than \$15,000. This is achieved through reduced handling of reported filings in paper forms and, therefore, the associated Division staff time in processing the reports. There does not appear to be any adverse effect if adopted.

Both immediate and long-term effects: The initial effect will be realized at the next annual renewal due March, 2009, and sustained at each annual renewal process thereafter.

4. The estimated cost to the agency for enforcement of the proposed regulation: None.
5. A description of and citation to any regulations of other state or local governmental agencies which the proposed regulation overlaps or duplicates, and a statement explaining why the duplication or overlapping is necessary. If the proposed regulation overlaps or duplicates a federal regulation, the notice must include the name of the regulating federal agency.

The Division is not aware of any overlap or duplication of the proposed regulation with any state, local or federal regulation.

6. If the regulation is required pursuant to federal law, a citation and description of the federal law.

The proposed regulation is not pursuant to federal law.

7. If the regulation includes provisions which are more stringent than a federal regulation that regulates the same activity, a summary of such provisions.

There are no federal regulations relevant to this activity.

8. A statement indicating whether the proposed regulation establishes a new fee or increases an existing fee.

No new fee is established.

9. A statement identifying the methods used by the agency in determining the impact on a small business prepared pursuant to subsection 3 of NRS 233B.0608.

The Division has determined there will be no adverse impact upon small business.

Persons wishing to comment upon the proposed action of the Division may appear at the scheduled public hearing or may address their comments, data, views or arguments, in written form, to the Division, 788 Fairview Drive, Suite 300, Carson City, Nevada 89701. **Written submissions must be received by the Division on or before October 31, 2008.** If no person who is directly affected by the proposed action appears to request time to make an oral presentation, the Division may proceed immediately to act upon any written submissions.

A copy of this notice and the regulation to be adopted will be on file at the State Library, 100 Stewart Street, Carson City, Nevada, for inspection by members of the public during business hours. Additional copies of the notice and the regulation to be adopted will be available at the offices of the Division, 788 Fairview Drive, Suite 300, Carson City, Nevada 89701, and 2501 East Sahara Avenue, Suite 302, Las Vegas, Nevada 89104, and in all counties in which an office of the agency is not maintained, at the main public library, for inspection and copying by members of the public during business hours. Copies of this notice and the proposed regulation will also be mailed to members of the public upon request. A reasonable fee may be charged for copies if it is deemed necessary. This does not apply to a public body subject to the Open Meeting Law.

Upon adoption of any regulation, the agency, if requested to do so by an interested person, either before adoption or within 30 days thereafter, shall issue a concise statement of the principal reasons for and against its adoption, and incorporate therein its reason for overruling the consideration urged against its adoption.

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
