## SUMMARY OF RECOMMENDATIONS

## JOINT INTERIM STANDING COMMITTEE ON GROWTH AND INFRASTRUCTURE

Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) 218E.320

This summary presents the recommendations approved by the Joint Interim Standing Committee on Growth and Infrastructure at its final meeting held on July 27, 2022. The bill draft request (BDR) will be forwarded to the Legislative Commission for transmittal to the 82<sup>nd</sup> Session of the Nevada Legislature.

## RECOMMENDATIONS FOR LEGISLATION

1. Draft a bill authorizing the installation and use of an automated traffic enforcement system by a governmental entity to enforce the provisions of NRS 484B.363, which prohibit certain vehicle maneuvers within a school zone or school crossing zone, and establish speed limits for a school zone or school crossing zone during certain times. (BDR –108)

## RECOMMENDATIONS FOR COMMITTEE ACTION

- 2. Draft a letter urging the Department of Employment, Training and Rehabilitation and the Department of Health and Human Services to coordinate with providers of broadband in Nevada to better identify households that qualify for affordable or low-cost Internet programs, such as the Affordable Connectivity Program, and specific programs offered by providers of broadband.
- 3. Include a statement in the Committee's final report urging the State of Nevada to maximize current federal funding and grants to connect unserved persons and communities throughout the state with broadband.
- 4. Include a statement in the Committee's final report encouraging the Department of Administration to prioritize electric vehicles (EV) as replacement options for fleet inventory at locations throughout Nevada that have available EV charging infrastructure.
