BDR 17: Existing law requires the Nevada Interscholastic Activities Association and the board of trustees of each school district to adopt a policy concerning the prevention and treatment of injuries to the head which may occur during a pupil's participation in sports which includes, without limitation, provisions regarding when a pupil must be removed from the activity and may return to the activity. This bill would revise such provisions and additionally require the inclusion of provisions regarding the return of such a pupil to the classroom environment and any necessary educational supports for such a pupil, commonly known as "return to learn" policies.
