 - Blends response tactics with school procedures
 - Reassuring to staff when sworn officer arrives as EM

- We have substantially increased the amount of training, drills and safety evaluations at our sites
- We study and learn from other incidents that occur throughout the world
- We have increased our training and coordination with other area agencies (REMSA, Sheriff, PD's, Charter Schools, etc.)
- We have realized that training needs to occur outside of just the school sites.
