THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1     **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State General  
2 Fund to the State Board of Examiners the sum ~~of \$658,489~~ \$697,880 for  
3 the following payments and increase in salary, retroactive to  
4 July 1, 2022, for personnel represented by the bargaining unit established  
5 in paragraph (g) of subsection 1 of NRS 288.515:  
6     (a) For all such personnel, an increase in salary for Fiscal Year 2022-  
7 2023 of 1 percent.  
8     (b) For such personnel with 10 or more years of continuous State  
9 service, a one-time payment of \$1,500.  
10    (c) For such personnel who hold:  
11       (1) A bachelor's degree, a one-time payment of \$900.  
12       (2) An associate's degree as his or her highest postsecondary  
13 degree, a one-time payment of \$500.  
14    ↪ An employee may not receive more than one payment pursuant to this  
15 paragraph.

1 2. Of the sum appropriated by subsection 1, not more than ~~[\$44,392]~~  
2 \$83,783 may be allocated and disbursed to the Nevada System of Higher  
3 Education.

4 3. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by subsection 1  
5 must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2023, by the entity to  
6 which the appropriation is made or any entity to which money from the  
7 appropriation is granted or otherwise transferred in any manner, and any  
8 portion of the appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any  
9 purpose after  
10 September 15, 2023, by either the entity to which the money was  
11 appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently granted or  
12 transferred, and must be reverted to the State General Fund on or before  
13 September 15, 2023.

14 **Sec. 2.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State Highway  
15 Fund to the State Board of Examiners the sum of \$891,725 for the  
16 following payments and increase in salary, retroactive to  
17 July 1, 2022, for personnel represented by the bargaining unit established  
18 in paragraph (g) of subsection 1 of NRS 288.515:

19 (a) For all such personnel, an increase in salary for Fiscal Year 2022-  
20 2023 of 1 percent.

21 (b) For such personnel with 10 or more years of continuous State  
22 service, a one-time payment of \$1,500.

23 (c) For such personnel who hold:

24 (1) A bachelor's degree, a one-time payment of \$900.

25 (2) An associate's degree as his or her highest postsecondary  
26 degree, a one-time payment of \$500.

27 ➔ An employee may not receive more than one payment pursuant to this  
28 paragraph.

29 2. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by subsection 1  
30 must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2023, by the entity to  
31 which the appropriation is made or any entity to which money from the  
32 appropriation is granted or otherwise transferred in any manner, and any  
33 portion of the appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any  
34 purpose after  
35 September 15, 2023, by either the entity to which the money was  
36 appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently granted or  
37 transferred, and must be reverted to the State Highway Fund on or before  
38 September 15, 2023.

39 **Sec. 3.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund  
40 to the State Board of Examiners the sum of \$19,737,672 for an increase in  
41 salary, retroactive to July 1, 2021, of 3 percent for Fiscal Year 2021-2022  
42 and Fiscal Year 2022-2023 for personnel represented by the bargaining  
43 units established in:

44 (a) Paragraph (a) of subsection 1 of NRS 288.515.

45 (b) Paragraph (e) of subsection 1 of NRS 288.515.

1 (c) Paragraph (f) of subsection 1 of NRS 288.515.

2 (d) Paragraph (i) of subsection 1 of NRS 288.515.

3 2. Of the sum appropriated by subsection 1, not more than \$1,219,659  
4 may be allocated and disbursed to the Nevada System of Higher  
5 Education.

6 3. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by subsection 1  
7 must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2023, by the entity to  
8 which the appropriation is made or any entity to which money from the  
9 appropriation is granted or otherwise transferred in any manner, and any  
10 portion of the appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any  
11 purpose after  
12 September 15, 2023, by either the entity to which the money was  
13 appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently granted or  
14 transferred, and must be reverted to the State General Fund on or before  
15 September 15, 2023.

16 **Sec. 4.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State Highway  
17 Fund to the State Board of Examiners the sum of \$80,024 for an increase  
18 in salary, retroactive to July 1, 2021, of 3 percent for Fiscal Year 2021-  
19 2022 and Fiscal Year 2022-2023 for personnel represented by the  
20 bargaining units established in:

21 (a) Paragraph (a) of subsection 1 of NRS 288.515.

22 (b) Paragraph (e) of subsection 1 of NRS 288.515.

23 (c) Paragraph (f) of subsection 1 of NRS 288.515.

24 (d) Paragraph (i) of subsection 1 of NRS 288.515.

25 2. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by subsection 1  
26 must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2023, by the entity to  
27 which the appropriation is made or any entity to which money from the  
28 appropriation is granted or otherwise transferred in any manner, and any  
29 portion of the appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any  
30 purpose after  
31 September 15, 2023, by either the entity to which the money was  
32 appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently granted or  
33 transferred, and must be reverted to the State Highway Fund on or before  
34 September 15, 2023.

35 **Sec. 5.** The approximate maximum salaries as set forth in section 1  
36 of chapter 309, Statutes of Nevada 2021, at page 1779, must be increased  
37 by an additional 2 percent commencing on  
38 April 1, 2023, and ending on June 30, 2023.

39 **Sec. 6.** 1. Except as otherwise provided in this act, to effect  
40 increases in salaries of 2 percent commencing on April 1, 2023, and ending  
41 on June 30, 2023, there is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund  
42 to the State Board of Examiners the sum of \$5,482,671, for the purpose of  
43 meeting any deficiencies which may be created between the appropriated  
44 money of the respective departments, commissions and agencies of the  
45 Executive and Judicial Departments of the State Government, as fixed by

1 the 81st Session of the Nevada Legislature and the requirements for  
2 salaries of the classified, unclassified and nonclassified personnel of those  
3 departments, commissions and agencies necessary under an adjusted pay  
4 plan to become effective on April 1, 2023.

5 2. Of the sum appropriated by subsection 1, not more than \$2,303,623  
6 may be allocated and disbursed to the Nevada System of Higher  
7 Education.

8 3. The State Board of Examiners, upon the recommendation of the  
9 Director of the Office of Finance in the Office of the Governor, may  
10 allocate and disburse to various departments, commissions and agencies of  
11 the Executive and Judicial Departments of the State Government, out of  
12 the money appropriated by this section such sums of money as may from  
13 time to time be required, which, when added to the money otherwise  
14 appropriated or available, equal the amount of money required to pay the  
15 salaries of the classified, unclassified and nonclassified employees of the  
16 respective departments, commissions and agencies under the adjusted pay  
17 plan. The sums appropriated by this section may not be allocated and  
18 disbursed to address a deficiency between the appropriated money, as  
19 fixed by the 81st Session of the Nevada Legislature and the requirements  
20 for salaries resulting from any circumstance other than the increases in  
21 salaries described in this section.

22 **Sec. 7.** 1. To effect increases in salaries of 2 percent commencing  
23 on April 1, 2023, and ending on June 30, 2023, there is hereby  
24 appropriated from the State Highway Fund to the State Board of  
25 Examiners the sum of \$566,090, for the purpose of meeting any  
26 deficiencies which may exist between the appropriated money of the  
27 Office of Finance in the Office of the Governor, Department of Motor  
28 Vehicles, Department of Public Safety and Nevada Transportation  
29 Authority, as fixed by the 81st Session of the Nevada Legislature and the  
30 requirements for salaries of classified and unclassified personnel of the  
31 Office of Finance in the Office of the Governor, Department of Motor  
32 Vehicles, Department of Public Safety and Nevada Transportation  
33 Authority necessary under an adjusted pay plan to become effective on  
34 April 1, 2023.

35 2. The State Board of Examiners, upon the recommendation of the  
36 Director of the Office of Finance in the Office of the Governor, may  
37 allocate and disburse to the Office of Finance in the Office of the  
38 Governor, Department of Motor Vehicles, the Department of Public Safety  
39 and the Nevada Transportation Authority out of the money appropriated by  
40 this section such sums of money as may from time to time be required,  
41 which, when added to the money otherwise appropriated or available,  
42 equal the amount of money required to meet and pay the salaries of the  
43 classified and unclassified employees of the Office of Finance in the  
44 Office of the Governor, Department of Motor Vehicles, Department of  
45 Public Safety and Nevada Transportation Authority under the adjusted pay

1 plan. The sums appropriated by this section may not be allocated and  
2 disbursed to address a deficiency between the appropriated money, as  
3 fixed by the 81st Session of the Nevada Legislature and the requirements  
4 for salaries resulting from any circumstance other than the increases in  
5 salaries described in this section.

6 **Sec. 8.** 1. When determining the allocations of the money  
7 appropriated by section 6 or 7 of this act, the State Board of Examiners  
8 shall not distribute money to an account beyond the maximum salary need  
9 amount determined for the account. Appropriations established for an  
10 account within a department, agency or commission must not be  
11 distributed to another account within the department, agency or  
12 commission if that action results in the distribution of money beyond the  
13 maximum salary need amount determined for the account.

14 2. The sums appropriated by sections 6 and 7 of this act must be  
15 applied to salaries notwithstanding the provisions of  
16 NRS 281.123.

17 **Sec. 9.** To effect increases in salaries of 2 percent commencing on  
18 April 1, 2023, and ending on June 30, 2023, there is hereby appropriated  
19 from the State General Fund to the Legislative Fund, the sum of \$248,387,  
20 for the purpose of meeting any deficiencies which may be created between  
21 the money appropriated to the Legislative Fund, as fixed by the 81st  
22 Session of the Nevada Legislature and the requirements for salaries of the  
23 personnel of the Legislative Counsel Bureau and of interim legislative  
24 operations necessary under an adjusted pay plan to become effective on  
25 April 1, 2023.

26 **Sec. 10.** 1. To effect the State of Nevada's share of increases in  
27 salaries of 2 percent commencing on April 1, 2023, and ending on June 30,  
28 2023, for employees of the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency, there is  
29 hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the State Board of  
30 Examiners the sum of not more than \$13,013. The amounts transferred  
31 must not be used to increase an employee's base salary unless the State of  
32 California provides the required 2-for-1 matching funds. If such matching  
33 funds are not provided by the State of California, any amounts provided to  
34 the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency by the State of Nevada must be used  
35 as a one-time salary bonus.

36 2. The State Board of Examiners, upon the recommendation of the  
37 Director of the Office of Finance in the Office of the Governor, may  
38 allocate and disburse to the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency out of the  
39 money appropriated by this section such sums of money as may from time  
40 to time be required, which, when added to the money otherwise  
41 appropriated or available, equal the amount of money required to meet and  
42 pay the State of Nevada's share of the salaries of the employees of the  
43 Tahoe Regional Planning Agency under the adjusted pay plan to become  
44 effective on April 1, 2023. The sums appropriated by this section may not  
45 be allocated and disbursed to address a deficiency between the

1 appropriated money as fixed by the 81st Session of the Nevada Legislature  
2 and the requirements for salaries resulting from any circumstance other  
3 than an increase in salaries described in this section.

4 **Sec. 11.** Any remaining balance of an appropriation made by section  
5 6, 7, 9 or 10 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after June  
6 30, 2023, by the entity to which the appropriation is made or any entity to  
7 which money from the appropriation is granted or otherwise transferred in  
8 any manner, and any portion of the appropriated money remaining must  
9 not be spent for any purpose after September 15, 2023, by either the entity  
10 to which the money was appropriated or the entity to which the money was  
11 subsequently granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the fund from  
12 which it was appropriated on or before September 15, 2023.

13 **Sec. 12.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.

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
