SENATE BILL 381 (R1)

Prohibits a landlord from requiring a tenant to pay certain charges. (BDR 10-650)

Senate Bill 381 prohibits landlords from charging tenants any fee or charge, including insurance or service contract deductibles or copayments, related to repairs, maintenance, or other work required to maintain the dwelling unit in a habitable condition. The bill provides an exception to allow landlords to charge for damages caused by a tenant's deliberate or negligent acts, or those of a member of the tenant's household or of persons on the premises with the tenant's consent.
