Proposed Amendments to NAC 392.105 and NAC 394.190

392.105 Immunization against mumps, hepatitis A, hepatitis B and varicella

- 1. The state board of health hereby declares the diseases of mumps, *hepatitis A*, *hepatitis B and varicella* to be [a] communicable diseases.
- 2. Unless excused because of religious belief or medical condition, a child may not be enrolled in a public school in this state unless he has been immunized against the mumps, *hepatitis A*, *hepatitis B and varicella*.

394.190 Immunization against mumps, hepatitis A, hepatitis B and varicella

- 1. The state board of health hereby declares the diseases of mumps, *hepatitis A*, *hepatitis B and varicella* to be $\frac{1}{160}$ communicable diseases.
- 2. Unless excused because of religious belief or medical condition, a child may not be enrolled in a private school in this state unless he has been immunized against the mumps, *hepatitis A*, *hepatitis B and varicella*.
