If no person who is directly affected by the proposed action appears to request time to make an oral presentation, the Nevada State Board of Nursing may proceed immediately to act upon any written submissions.

A copy of this notice and the amendments and additions to the regulations will be on file at the State Library, 100 Stewart Street, Carson City, Nevada. Additional copies will be available at the Reno and Las Vegas offices of the Nevada State Board of Nursing for inspection and copying by members of the public during business hours and will be posted on its website at nursingboard.state.nv.us. Copies will also be mailed to members of the public upon request. A reasonable fee may be charged for copies if it is deemed necessary.

Upon adoption of any regulation, the agency, if requested to do so by an interested person, either before adoption or within 30 days thereafter, will issue a concise statement of the principal reasons for and against its adoption, and incorporate therein its reason for overruling the consideration urged against its adoption.

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PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE STATE BOARD OF NURSING

Information on the following is provided on the attachment pursuant to the requirements of NRS 233B.060:

- 1. NAC 632. New "Physician Assistant" defined.
- 2. NAC 632.071 "Prescription" defined. Amend to add physician assistant.
- 3. NAC 632.220 Medication and treatment of patients; response to orders. Amend to add physician assistant.
- 4. NAC 632.224 Supervision of others; establishment of authorized scope of practice; verification of competency. Amend to add physician assistant.
- 5. NAC 632.234 Performance of therapeutic procedures and duties of scrub nurse. Amend to add physician assistant.
- 6. NAC 632.249 Identification by appropriate title required; identification requirements for telenursing. Amend to change identification requirement.
- 7. NAC 632.257 Authorization to issue written prescriptions for poisons, dangerous drugs or devices. Amend to allow prescriptive authority for controlled substances
- 8. NAC 632.258 Review of application for authority to prescribe poisons, dangerous drugs or devices. Amend to allow prescriptive authority for controlled substances.
- 9. NAC 632.259 Poisons, dangerous drugs or devices which may be prescribed; change and review of list. Amend to allow prescriptive authority for controlled substances.
- 10. NAC 632.260 Qualifications for certificate of recognition; practice by student. Amend to delete BSN agreement for APN application
- 11. NAC 632.295 Denial, suspension or revocation of certificate; unprofessional conduct. Amend to allow prescriptive authority for controlled substances.
- 12. NAC 632.450 Procedures delegable to licensed practical nurses. Amend to add physician assistant; and, normal saline.
- 13. NAC 632.930 Reporting of disciplinary action. Amend reporting of disciplinary action.

The Nevada State board of Nursing approved proposed regulation changes to NAC 632 in wording and concept on September 19, 2001. They include:

A. NAC 632.(new), NAC 632.071, 632.220, 632.224, 632.234 are all amended to add "physician assistant" to health professionals who may give orders to nurses. This change is required based on changes made by the 2001 Legislature to NRS 632.

There will be no economic effect of these regulations on businesses that are regulated by the applicable administrative code.

There will be no economic effect on the public

There will be no additional expenses for enforcement of this regulation.

B. NRS 632.450 is amended to add "physician assistant" to health professionals who may give orders to nurses. This change is required based on changes made by the 2001 Legislature to NRS 632. Also, NAC 632.450 is amended to add "normal" saline.

There will be no economic effect of these regulations on businesses that are regulated by the applicable administrative code.

There will be no economic effect on the public

There will be no additional expenses for enforcement of this regulation.

C. NAC 632.249 is amended to change the requirement of a licensee to wear identification containing first name and initial of last name. This change is required based on changes made by the 2001 Legislature to NRS 632.

There will be no economic effect of these regulations on businesses that are regulated by the applicable administrative code.

There will be no economic effect on the public

There will be no additional expenses for enforcement of this regulation.

D. NAC 632.257, 632.258, 632.259, 632.295 are amended to expand the scope of prescribing privileges for advanced practitioners of nursing. This change is required based on changes made by the 2001 Legislature to NRS 632.

E. NAC 632.260 is amended to delete the option for a BSN agreement.

F. NAC 632.930 is amended to expand the type of disciplinary actions to be reported to any national repository. This change reflects the intent of NRS 632.320
