# PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE DIVISION OF INSURANCE OF THE DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS AND INDUSTRY

## NOTICE OF WORKSHOPS TO SOLICIT COMMENTS ON PROPOSED REGULATIONS

September 24, 2001

The Department of Business and Industry, Division of Insurance (Division) is proposing new regulations pertaining to privacy of consumer financial information, the assessment of insurers for the special investigative account, and interest on preneed contracts. A workshop has been set for 10:00 a.m., on November 1, 2001, at the offices of the Division, 788 Fairview Drive, Suite 300, Carson City, Nevada 89701. The purpose of the workshop is to solicit comments from interested persons on the following general topics addressed in the proposed regulations.

- 1. Consumer Financial Information: The proposed regulation establishes the requirements for privacy notices sent to consumers, limits the disclosure of nonpublic personal financial information to nonaffiliated third parties, and establishes the opt out requirements for disclosure of information.
- 2. Assessment of Insurers: The proposed regulation establishes the procedure for determining the pro rata assessment of insurers for funding the special investigative account to investigate certain violations and fraudulent acts.
- 3. Interest on Preneed Contracts: The proposed regulation establishes the interest rate to be paid on preneed contracts and identifies those contracts for which interest must be paid.

Members of the insurance industry, business community, and the public are also invited to comment on any impact the proposed regulations may have on small businesses. The Division has reviewed the proposed regulations and determined that they may impose a direct or significant impact on a small business, or directly restrict the formation, operation, or expansion of a small business. The regulation on the assessment of insurers should not have any adverse impact on small businesses.

#### NOTICE OF INTENT TO ACT UPON REGULATIONS

Notice of Hearing for the Adoption of Regulations of the Department of Business and Industry, Division of Insurance

The Department of Business and Industry, Division of Insurance (Division) will hold a public hearing at 10:00 a.m., on November 1, 2001, immediately following a public workshop, at the offices of the Division, 788 Fairview Drive, Suite 300, Carson City, Nevada 89701. The purpose of the hearing is to receive comments from all interested persons regarding the adoption of regulations pertaining to the assessment of insurers for the special investigative account.

## REGULATIONS CONCERNING THE ASSESSMENT OF INSURERS FOR THE SPECIAL INVESTIGATIVE ACCOUNT

The following information is provided pursuant to the requirements of NRS 233B.060:

- 1. The proposed regulation is needed to establish the procedure for determining the pro rata assessment of insurers for the special investigative account to investigate certain violations and fraudulent acts pursuant to chapter 60, Statutes of Nevada 2001, at page 479 (A.B. 60).
- 2. The proposed regulation would apply the assessment to all insurers authorized to transact insurance in the state of Nevada as of June 1 of the year of assessment and apportion the assessment among insurers subject to the limits prescribed in A.B. 60.
- 3. Estimated economic effect of the regulation:

On the business which it is to regulate:

The proposed regulation should have neither an immediate nor long-term impact on the industry.

On the public:

The proposed regulations should have no economic impact on the public.

- 4. The Division may incur some additional expense to enforce the proposed regulation that cannot be measured at this time.
- 5. The Division is not aware of any overlap or duplication of the regulation with any state, local or federal regulation.
- 6. The proposed regulation does not establish any new fees or increase an existing fee.

Persons wishing to comment upon the proposed action of the Division may appear at the scheduled public hearing or may address their comments, data, views or arguments, in written form, to the Division, 788 Fairview Drive, Suite 300, Carson City, Nevada 89701. Written submissions must be received by the Division on or before October 29, 2001. If no person who is directly affected by the proposed action appears to request time to make an oral presentation, the Division may proceed immediately to act upon any written submissions.

# PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE DIVISION OF INSURANCE OF THE DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS AND INDUSTRY

### REGULATION FOR THE ASSESSMENT OF INSURERS FOR THE SPECIAL INVESTIGATIVE ACCOUNT

Authority: NRS 679B.158

Section 1. NAC 679B.154 is hereby amended to read as follows:

- 1. The commissioner will *annually* determine the assessment for the special investigative account by dividing the amount of money that the legislature authorized for expenditure for that year for the support of the program established pursuant to NRS 679B.153 [by the number of] among insurers who hold a certificate of authority in this state as of June 1 of the year of assessment. The assessment shall be apportioned among the insurers pro rata based upon the total amount of premiums written in Nevada as reported on the annual statements filed with the commissioner for the preceding year. An insurer with no written premium in Nevada for the preceding year shall be placed in the lowest tier of assessments.
- 2. The pro rata assessment shall be determined by calculating the maximum assessment allowed pursuant to subsection 5 of NRS 679B.158 for all insurers and comparing it to the amount authorized for expenditure from the special investigative account. The pro rata amounts so assessed must not exceed the limits established by subsection 5 of NRS 679B.158.

  [2] 3. The division will mail to each company a notice of the amount of the assessment on or before July 1 of each year.

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
