PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE BOARD OF WILDLIFE COMMISSIONERS

COMMISSION GENERAL REGULATION 301 (LCB File #R192-01)

Authority: NRS 501.105, 501.181, 502.250

Explanation: Amends NAC 502.334 to increase the fee for resident deer tags for special seasons.

NOTE: Matter in *italics* is new; matter within brackets [] is to be omitted.

Section 1. NAC 502.334 is hereby amended to read as follows:

NAC 502.334

- 1. A resident must pay \[\frac{\$20}{20} \\$25 \text{ for a tag for a special season to hunt deer.} \]
- 2. A nonresident must pay the following fees for tags:

(a) Antelope	\$250
(b) Bighorn sheep	1000
(c) Deer (special seasons)	200
(d) Mountain lion	100
(e) Elk	1000
